Today, XXth generation of the Democracy School, organized by the Centre for Civic Education (CCE), with the support of the Friedrich Ebert Stiftung (FES) successfully ended it's work. **Formal diploma ceremony was organized on 28 November, during which participants received diplomas by Radovan Radonjić, the leader of the School, Daliborka Uljarević, executive director of the CCE and Ivana Račić, programme coordinator in FES.**

The aim of the school is to contribute to the development of democratic culture in Montenegro through informing and educating citizens about democracy, its values and ways of its implementation.

School is consisted of four modules throughout students acquired the necessary knowledge about:

- The idea of democracy, its meaning and the origins
- Positive and negative features of democracy;
- What does democracy entails - as a process of exercising of individual human rights and freedoms, as a way of social life and relations, the form of government and the institutional system, and in which forms it could be misused
- How to develop the skill of critical observation and tolerant, responsible and argumentative public communication and participation in the process of public policies creation and their implementation.

Over the past few months, 31 participants attended and successfully finished the School, mostly representatives of NGO's, political parties, journalists, local and governments' officials, students and others. In the framework of the School, participants had the opportunity to have lectures by renewed domestic and international lecturers, professors of the Montenegrin and the faculties from the region, representatives of NGO's and journalists.
