

Public Statement

Coalition of the below signed 70 NGOs notes that not even more than two weeks after Mr. Aleksandar Sasa Zekovic (Human Rights researcher and member of the Council for the Civilian Control of Police in Montenegro) has reported serious threats to his life, the police did not discover the perpetrators of those criminal acts probably performed in violation of official duty.

The coalition of 70 NGOs requests from the police and the state prosecutor to urgently investigate the case and inform the public of the results of investigation, bearing in mind that the threats, i.e. the voices of perpetrators have been recorded on tape.

Only by efficient discovery of perpetrators the police and the state prosecutor will show that they function in accordance with the law to the end of protecting the security of citizens and human rights in line with international standards, as provided by the Criminal Procedure Code, the Police Act and the Constitution of the Republic of Montenegro.
