NEW REGULATION IS ALREADY VIOLATED

Centre for Civic Education (CCE) indicates that the new Regulation on the criteria for determining the users and manner of the allocation of portion of the lottery games income that come into force on 07/08/2010 is already violated. Namely, the Commission has not informed the public on the Decision on allocation of funds for 2010 within the legally prescribed deadline.

CCE calls the Commission to immediately publicise the Decision on allocation of funds, since the deadline of 30 days during which time they had to bring and publicise official Decision on allocation of funds for 2010 has largely passed, which caused the violation of the Regulation and sent bad message to the stakeholders and public.

The Call for allocation of funds during 2010 has unacceptably and unjustifiably being delayed. Further prolongation of the publication of Decisions leads to additional question of the nature of support to the programmes and projects of NGO sector financed from this budget and make the work of the NGOs difficult.

CCE underlines that will publicly react to any further violation of the Regulation, particularly when these misconducts affect users of these sources.
