







EDUCATION FOR SUCCESSFUL PROCESS OF EUROPEAN INTEGRATIONS

VI generation of the European Integration School and III generation of the European Integration School for the North of Montenegro organised by Centre for Civic Education, Centre for Development of NGOs (CDNGOs) and European movement in Montenegro (EMiM) with the support of Foundation Open Society Institute - Office in Montenegro have started with the work.

As in previous years the interest for the schools was enormous and this is proven by huge number of applicants (211 applications for 30 planned and accepted participants in European Integration School and 20 participants in Regional European Integration School in Bijelo Polje). European Integration School is the oldest programme of non-formal education in field of European Integrations in Montenegro. This continuous interest represent great acknowledgement to the organisers, but also an obligation to fulfill the expectations of new participants with the quality of programme.

In selection of candidates the organisers were driven by criteria as follows: proportional sector representation, diverse ethnic groups and political profiles, equal gender representation, as well as with the education profile and possibility of application of the gained knowledge.

So far, the School has been successfully completed by 210 participants. They implement their knowledge in governmental institutions, non-governmental organisations, business sector, judiciary, media, etc.

The School has as one of its main values the transparency of work. Therefore, the complete list of participants of this generation with their short biographies will soon be posted on our web site.

Call for candidates for enrollment into next generations of the European Integration School is planned for February 2008.
