OPEN LETTER TO THE DIRECTOR OF THE TELEVISION OF MONTENEGRO

Dear Mr Vojičić,

By the decision of the Parliament, the RTCG Council is not completed because of the violation of the Law on Public Broadcasting Services RTCG by the ruling coalition in the Parliament of Montenegro and it will not work and make decisions from 1 January 2008.

During the debate on this issue in the Parliament, appointed members of the RTCG Council were subjected to false claims with the goal of their personal discreditation, and discreditation of those who have appointed these members of the RTCG Council.

This topic for a long time causes public attention. Also, the public is interested in the problems that public service is facing.

Since the RTCG Council is the highest authority, and taking into the account the fact that its functioning is conditioned by the work of members of the Council who are representatives of different institutions and organizations, we urge you to organize within program schedule of the RTCG special pieces that will highlight issues related to respect of Law and the functioning of the RTCG Council on the objective and systematic way.

We believe that by organizing of the special TV pieces on this topic the citizens of Montenegro would be given the opportunity to obtain more information on the challenges the RTCG is facing. At the same time, it would be an indication that the public service has the courage to speak about the problems in his own house, which, let's not forget, pay all citizens of Montenegro, including the members of non-governmental organizations, members of trade unions and other civil society institutions to which appointed us for their representatives in the Council of RTCG.
