Appeal to all political parties to respect the Law and confirm nominations to the RTCG Council

Non-governmental organisations urge the MPs of the Parliament of Montenegro to respect the Law on Public broadcasting services of RTCG and confirm appointments of all nominated members to the RTCG Council for whom nomination acts have been submitted in line with regulations.

The responsible Parliamentary committee unanimously found that the procedure of nominating members to the Council was valid, without any objections.

By confirming appointments of all RTCG members the Parliament would ensure further operation of the RTCG Council as well as transformation of RTCG into genuine public service and demonstrate its respect for the will of the civil society.
