PREPARATIOS FOR THE FAST FORWARD HUMAN RIGHTS FILM FESTIVAL 2012 STARTED

Centre for Civic Education (CCE), organizer of the Fast Forward Human Rights Film Festival and Mladen Vusurovic, director of the production distribution Ltd. Tricontinental from Cetinje and selector-director of the International Documentary Film Festival "Beldocs" have signed a Memorandum of Understanding, with the primary aim of establishing cooperation and development in the field transfer of experience, knowledge and development vision of the Fast Forward Human Rights Film Festival.

Fast Forward Human Rights Film Festival is the first, and for now the only film festival, which is dedicated to the promotion of human rights and social sobriety through this artistic expression. This festival drew Podgorica and Montenegro on the cultural map of the region, which for many year nurtures a similar type of festival events that seek to inform the public with recent production engaged in documentary and feature film, and to make sensible and informed vulnerable societies in post-conflict areas concerning the issue of human rights whose violation made the world distinctive this region.

The Memorandum provides that Mladen Vušurović (Beldocs) for CCE do the selection and programme proposal of Fast Forward Human Rights Film Festival, e.g. to propose films that would be presented at the Fast Forward Human Rights Film Festival 2012 and to provide copyright-distribution license for the films on the programme. This is enabling the Fast Forward Human Rights Film Festival to have a quality and rich programme of great movies of the latest productions that have already taken numerous nominations, recognitions and awards around the world.

In the aim of the continuing cooperation, the agreement is of long-term nature, designed to last to the extent in which cooperation contributes to fulfilling of the set goals, further development and positioning of the Fast Forward Human Rights Film Festival.
