## **OTHERS TO FOLLOW VELJOVIC'S EXAMPLE**

Centre for Civic Education (CCE) welcomes the directive by the director of the Police Directorate, Mr Veselin Veljovic to all police units to instantly remove all party insignia from their offices.

CCE urges other officials of the Government of Montenegro, public institutions and other institutions financed through the Budget of the Republic of Montenegro to remove all party insignia and portraits of the DPS leader that have adorned those institutions so far in an outright violation of the law.

CCE will persist in monitoring all actions undertaken accordingly on the part of the chiefs of the organizational units of the Police Directory to whom the above order relates, as well as other persons responsible for the implementation of the law in this domain, and accordingly inform the national and international public.

CCE reminds of its continuous efforts to draw public attention to this violation of the law, and to urge all responsible organs to undertake the necessary measures in order to remove these compromising items from the public offices.

CCE considers this a small, but symbolically important victory of civil society organisations in a long process to de-politicise public institutions – which is a necessary step in democratization of Montenegrin society.
