## **RAE TO PUBLISH THE WHOLE REQUESTS OF MEE AND MTS, AND THE GOVERNMENT TO MAKE PUBLIC THE ENERGY ACCOUNT FOR 2011**

We urge the Regulatory Agency for Energy (RAE) to make public, in accordance with its own regulations, in its entirety the demands of Montenegrin Electric Enterprise (MEE) and Montenegro transmission system (MTS).

With provisional methodology for determining regulatory revenue and cost for use of the transmission and distribution system, as well as regulatory income of public supplier and regulated tariffs for electricity supply, it was determined that “a complete and clear request the Agency publishes on its website”. Only upon publishing the overall demands it is possible to fully inform the Montenegrin public and interested institutions. **For this purpose we urge the RAE to extend the deadline for submission of opinions and observations until the end of this month (January).**

Without the comprehensive information on the request of MEE and MTS and only on the basis of statements of RAE, which describe the demands, is not possible to equally participate in the discussion on the content of above mentioned demands.

**We call the Government of Montenegro to publish the Energy Account for 2011, which was, according to the announcement, adopted on December 16, 2010.**
