CCE RECOGNIZED AS A CREDIBLE ORGANISER OF THE ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAMMES

Executive director of the *Centre for Civic Education (CCE)*, Daliborka Uljarević participated in the conference "*Adult Education in Europe outside of the European Union*" organized by the *European Association for Adult Education (EAEA)* and the *Institute for International Cooperation of the German Adult Education Association (DVV International)* which ends today in the Ukrainian capital Kiev.

The conference which was held from 11 to 14 September brought together representatives of organizations for adult education from the South East and Eastern Europe and the Southern Caucasus, the members of the organization EAEA and other experts. Amongst the participants there were prominent experts in the field of adult education from a variety of structures, from 15 countries: Germany, Belgium, Denmark, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Georgia, Montenegro, Moldova, Macedonia, Serbia, Turkey and finally, from Ukraine.

The aim of the meeting was to introduce the participants with European policies and their adult education programmes in countries outside the EU, as well as to provide a framework that will clearly articulate their position towards these programmes. The conference highlighted the importance of sharing the latest news on European policies and programs that can assist in the exchange of experiences among the participating countries, as well as on European policies, strategies, programs and projects.

CCE is the only NGO in Montenegro, which was invited to participate in this important event, because it has been recognized as a credible organizer of adult education programs. CCE since its foundation strives the adult education, and the general principle of lifelong learning to become part of the Montenegrin practice by organizing a variety of quality educational programs in the areas of democracy, human rights, European integration and active citizenship, which are open to all citizens who want to work on personal and professional development.
