CCE and dvv International organizers of regional workshop
"Lifelong Learning and Civil Society Development"

The Centre for Civic Education (CCE) and the Institute for International Cooperation of the German Adult Education Association (dvv international) is organizing a regional workshop on "Lifelong learning and the civil society development," from 11 to 13 november, which gathered civil society organizations for adult education from Croatia, Kosovo, Macedonia, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Serbia.

The aim of the workshop is to gather representatives of the NGO sector working on education for active citizenship, lifelong learning, and the development of civil society to jointly analyze policy and practices in this area, the possibility of common action, sharing of information, lessons learned and concepts concerning lifelong learning in order to further lobbying and advocacy. Key topics that were discussed were the role of adult education and lifelong learning in enabling active citizenship, as well as similarities in concepts of citizenship learning in the region of Southeast Europe.

CCE for years, continuously invest efforts into adult education that should become quite normal sequence of anyone's development.

Regional workshop on "*Lifelong learning and civil society development*" was opened by **Beate Schmidt-Behlau**, regional director of DVV International South-East Europe, and Daliborka Uljarević, executive director of the Centre for Civic Education.
