Gledaj i pamti

Uljuljkujući se, svaki put, izvjesnošću sretnoga kraja i nužnošću progresa. Ali, ako smo išta uspjeli naučiti u sporom hodu ka svijesti o neotuđivosti ljudskog dostojanstva, to je da ničeg spontanog i izvjesnog na ovom putu nema i da se lakše pada unatrag, no što se ide unaprijed.

Jesmo li dovoljno gledali i jesmo li dovoljno pamtili kada se ljudskost drugih mijenjala za vlastiti komfor, kada smo umjesto utočišta pružali izručenja, kada smo birali da ne vidimo logore i odlučivali da ne pamtimmo stratišta? Kako smo tada sebi objasnjavali ljudskost, kome smo je pripisivali, a kome otpisivali i čega smo se to igrali, ne preuzimajući odgovornost?

Nekada davno i negdje daleko voljeli bismo da smo uspjeli ostaviti za sobom ljepljive aveti fašizma, ropstva, siromaštva, eksploatacije, bolesti i rata. Možda smo i mogli, ali nismo. Oni su naša sadašnjost, i naša stvarnost. O tome svjedoče, na svoj način, i filmovi devete selekcije Festivala filma o ljudskim pravima UBRZAJ 2018. Filmovi koji se ne boje, koji sprovode maštovitu vivisekciju društvenih nepravdi, ironiziraju moćne i sanjaju glasno. Filmovi koji se bore i kojima se bori.

Je li dovoljno samo gledati i pamtititi? Naravno da nije, ali taj minimalni zahtjev lišava tankog alibija neznanja i predstavlja, možda prvi, korak ka odgovornosti.

Watch, and remember

The talk of human rights, whether in politics, science, or arts, sometimes comes across as a moving tale that the humankind tells while tucking itself to sleep, murmuring it almost by hearth, terrifying and inspiring itself in turns by the wickedness of monsters and the revolts of the brave. Lulling itself, every time, by the certainty of the happy end and the inevitability of progress. And yet if we had learned anything on our laborious trudge towards full awareness of the inalienability of human dignity, it is that there is nothing certain or inevitable about this path, and that falling behind is much easier than forging ahead.

Have we watched carefully enough, do we remember enough of those times when we traded the humanity of others for own comfort, when we surrendered the victims instead of sheltering them, when we choose not to see the camps and not to remember places of suffering? How did we understand humanity then? Who counted as human and who did not? And what were we playing at, refusing responsibility?

We would like to have left far behind and long ago the obstinate ghosts of fascism, slavery, poverty, exploitation, disease, and war. Maybe would could have done so, but we did not. They are our present too, and our reality. This is what the films of the ninth selection of the FAST FORWARD 2018 Human Rights Film Festival are telling us, each in its own way. These films are not afraid: with courage and imagination they cut to the quick of social injustices, mock the powerful and dream aloud. Films that fight and in which people fight.

Is it enough to just watch and remember? Of course not, but this minimal entreaty already lifts the thin alibi of ignorance and represents, perhaps, the first step towards accountability.



● SINOPSIS

Početkom 90-ih godina prošlog vijeka, patriotska muzika je igrala važnu političku ulogu u zemljama bivše Jugoslavije. Avioni, tenkovi, bombe, automatske puške, mediji i propaganda bili su oružja u ratu. Ipak, najglasnije su bile pjesme. Jedni su u njima opisivali košmar u kojem su se našli, a drugi su potvrđivali svoju političku lojalnost. Nacionalna radiotelevizija je pjesmu smatrala važnim oblikom političke borbe, pa ih je naručivala, finansirala, snimala i intenzivno emitovala.

I dvadeset godina nakon završetka rata njihov soundtrack izaziva pažnju i budi emocije.

Miroslav Sikavica rođen je 1975. godine u Zagrebu. Reditelj je poznatih dokumentaraca iz serijskog Direct TV programa Fade-In, koji se bavi problemima mlađih i njihovim pravima. Režirao je tridesetak dokumentarnih filmova. Njegov kratki fikcijski film „Zvir“ premijerno je prikazan 2016. godine na filmskom festivalu u Kanu gdje je nagrađen posebnim priznanjem.

● SYNOPSIS

In the early 1990s, patriotic music played an important political role in the countries of the former Yugoslavia. Aircrafts, tanks, bombs, automatic rifles, media and propaganda were the War weaponry of choice. Nevertheless, the loudest were the songs. Ones used them to describe the nightmares that befell them, others to confirm their political loyalty. The national TV broadcaster considered music an important form of political 'fight', so they commissioned, financed, recorded and intensely broadcasted it. Even twenty years after the end of the Homeland War, its soundtrack still attracts attention and sparks emotions.

● ABOUT THE AUTOR

Miroslav Sikavica was born in 1975 in Zagreb. He is the director of well-known documentaries from the serial Direct TV programme *Fade-In*, which deals with youth problems, as well as their rights. He directed thirty documentaries. His short fiction film '*Zvir*' was premiered in 2016 at the Cannes film festival where he got special award.

● SINOPSIS

Siniša Mesjak je ambiciozan političar koji se nađe u središtu skandala. Kako bi ga sklonio od javnosti, premijer ga šalje na Trećiće, izolovano ostrvo bez telefona i interneta, čiji stanovnici govore nerazumljivim dijalektom.

Autor je zapaženog srednjemetražnog filma „Vidimo se“ (1995), koji je nagrađen na Filmskom festivalu u Cottbusu, dokumentarnih filmova „Drugi kat, podrum“ (1991) i „Hotel Sunja“ (1992), kao i segmenta „Dan otpora“ u dugometražnom omnibusu Zagrebačke priče vol. 3 (2015). Radio je kao reditelj, scenarista i *script-doctor* za HRT i RTL, a režirao je i šezdesetak reklama. *Osmi povjerenik* njegov je prvi dugometražni igrani film.

● SYNOPSIS

Siniša Mesjak is an ambitious politician who gets involved into scandal. In order to keep him away from the public eye, the Prime Minister sends him to Trećić, an isolated Croatian island with no telephone or internet signal, and which inhabitants speak with the dialect that he does not understand.

There, he is in charge for organizing local elections – a task that seven commissioners before him failed to accomplish.

Ivan Salaj was born in 1969 in Zagreb. He is screenplay writer and director. He is the author of 'See You' (1995), a mid-length film, awarded at the Film fest Cottbus, documentary films 'Second Floor, Basement' (1991) and 'Hotel Sunja' (1992), as well as 'Resistance Day', which was part of the feature anthology Zagreb Stories Vol. 3 (2015). He worked as director, screenwriter and script-doctor on Croatian Radio television and RTL, and has directed around 60 commercials. The Eighth Commissioner is his first feature.

● SINOPSIS

Bez obzira na to da li živite u Zagrebu, Podgorici, Sarajevu ili Beogradu struja koju koristite u vašem domu u najvećoj meri je dobijena postupkom spaljivanja uglja. Preciznije – 70% potrošene struje dobijeno je iz regionalnih termoelektrana čiji je rad štetan po prirodu i zdravlje ljudi. Za Evropsku uniju ovaj procenat je apsolutno neprihvatljiv i od zemalja regiona očekuje se da počnu sa primjenom alternativnih rješenja.

Film prati Irmu Popović Dujmović, aktivistkinju Svjetskog fonda za zaštitu prirode (WWF Adria), koja na svom putu kroz Hrvatsku, Bosnu, Srbiju i Crnu Goru otkriva na koji način je regionalni plan masovne izgradnje malih hidroelektrana umjesto rješenja zapravo stvorio brojne nove probleme. Devastacija prirode, otvorena pobuna ljudi protiv malih hidroelektrana, kao i korupcija prilikom njihove izgradnje, samo su neke, ne i najcrnje, sjenke zelene energije.

Dragan Gmizić je profesionalni novinar i TV autor, i od 1998. godine angažovan u oblasti društveno-političkih, ekonomskih i ekoloških pitanja u Vojvodini, Srbiji i regionu nekadašnje Jugoslavije. Autor je brojnih reportaža, informativnih emisija i dokumentarnih filmova emitovanih na srpskim i međunarodnim TV stanicama. Za dokumentarni film *Ravnica bez ptica* nagrađen je Nagradom za istraživačko novinarstvo koju dodjeljuje Delegacija Evropske unije u Srbiji, kao i nagradom

Najbolji srpski film 2016, koju dodjeljuje Festival zelene kulture - Greenfest. Dva puta je nominovan za godišnju nagradu NUNS-a za istraživačko novinarstvo - 2015. i 2017. Jedan je od osnivača Greenfiled produkcije iz Novog Sada.

● SYNOPSIS

Regardless of whether you live in Zagreb, Podgorica, Sarajevo or Belgrade, the electricity you use in your home is mostly obtained by coal burning. More precisely – 70% of the used up electricity is received from regional thermal power plants whose work is harmful to the nature and the health of people. For the European Union this is absolutely unacceptable and countries in the region are expected to start using alternative solutions.

Film follows Irma Popović Dujmović, WWF Adria activist, on the road through Croatia, Bosnia, Serbia and Montenegro, discovering how the regional plan for mass construction of small hydropower plants creates multiple new problems instead of solving them. The devastation of nature, the open revolt of people against small hydropower plants as well as the corruption in their construction are just some, but not the darkest, shadows of green energy.

● ABOUT THE AUTHOR

Dragan Gmizić is professional journalist and TV author. Since 1998 he has been engaged in the domain of socio-political, economic and environmental issues in Vojvodina, Serbia and the region of former Yugoslavia. He is the author of many reports, newscasts and documentaries broadcasted on Serbian and international TV stations. His documentary *Birdless Plains* was awarded by EU Delegation to Serbia, as well as by Greenfest Green Culture Festival as Best Serbian Movie in 2016. He was twice nominated for NUNS annual award for investigative journalism in 2015 and 2017. He is one of the founders of Greenfiled production from Novi Sad.

● SINOPSIS

Nevjerovatan film o ženi robinji u srcu savremene Evrope. Rediteljka Bernadet Tuza Riter je slučajno saznala za nju kada joj se njena "gospodarica" Eta hvalila da ima sluškinju. Tada je zatražila dozvolu da je snimi i Eta joj je to i dozvolila – za 300 eura mjesecno.

Mariš, pedesetdvogodišnja Mađarica, posljednjih deset godina služi jednu porodicu, radeći 20 sati dnevno, bez plate. Njeni tlačitelji su joj oduzeli lična dokumenta, a kuću ne može da napusti bez dozvole. Prema njoj se ophode neljudski, živi na ostacima hrane, bez kreveta u kojem bi spavala. Prisustvo kamere joj pomaže da shvati kako nije u potpunosti prepuštena sebi. Polako se opušta i pokazuje prve znake povjerenja. Ohrabrena je i saopštava svoj plan: „Pobjeći ću!“ Film prati njen herojski put ka slobodi.

● O AUTORKI



Bernadett Tuza-Ritter je mađarska rediteljka i montažerka nezavisne produkcije, čiji su fokus kreativni dokumentarci i fikcija. Studirala je režiju i montažu na Univerzitetu za pozorišnu i filmsku umjetnost u Budimpešti. Kao montažerka, bila je angažovana na brojnim međunarodnim projektima, kratkim filmovima i dokumentarcima. Tokom 2013. godine, radila

je kao rediteljka na projektu „Cinetrain – Russian Winter“ koji je osvojio nagradu publike na festivalu dokumentarnog filma

Vision du Reel. Članica je HSE i Mađarske akademije filma. Njen prvi dugometražni dokumentarni film "Zarobljena" imao je premijeru u okviru glavnog takmičarskog programa IDFA 2017 u Amsterdamu. Poslije te svjetske premijere, izabran je za takmičenje Svjetskog dokumentarnog filma na Sandens filmskom festivalu u januaru 2018. godine, postavši prvi mađarski dugometražni film koji se ikada takmičio na ovom festivalu. Tuza-Ritter je posebno zainteresovana za eksperimentisanje sa jezikom filma i pomjeranje granica između fikcije i dokumentaristike.

● SYNOPSIS

An incredible movie about the women who has been kept as slave in the heart of contemporary Europe. Director Bernadet Tuza Ritter accidentally heard about her when her „mistress“ Eta told her that she had a slave. She asked for permission to film her, and Eta allowed her to - for exchange of 300 euros per month.

Marish, a 52-year-old Hungarian woman has been serving a family for a decade, working 20 hours a day, without getting paid. Her personal documents were taken from her by her oppressors, and she is not allowed to leave the house without permission. Treated like an animal, she only gets leftovers to eat and no bed to sleep in. The presence of the camera helps her realize she isn't completely alone. She begins to relax and to show signs of trust. She gathers her courage and reveals her plan: "I am going to escape!" The film follows her heroic journey back to freedom.

● ABOUT THE AUTHOR

Bernadett Tuza-Ritter is Hungarian independent filmmaker and editor specializing in creative documentaries and fiction. She studied directing and editing at the University of Theatre and Film Arts Budapest. As editor, she was engaged on numerous international projects, short movies and documentaries. Failed by a healthcare system that is largely ignorant of their existence, they learn to find strength in each other and their small, but strong community.


