

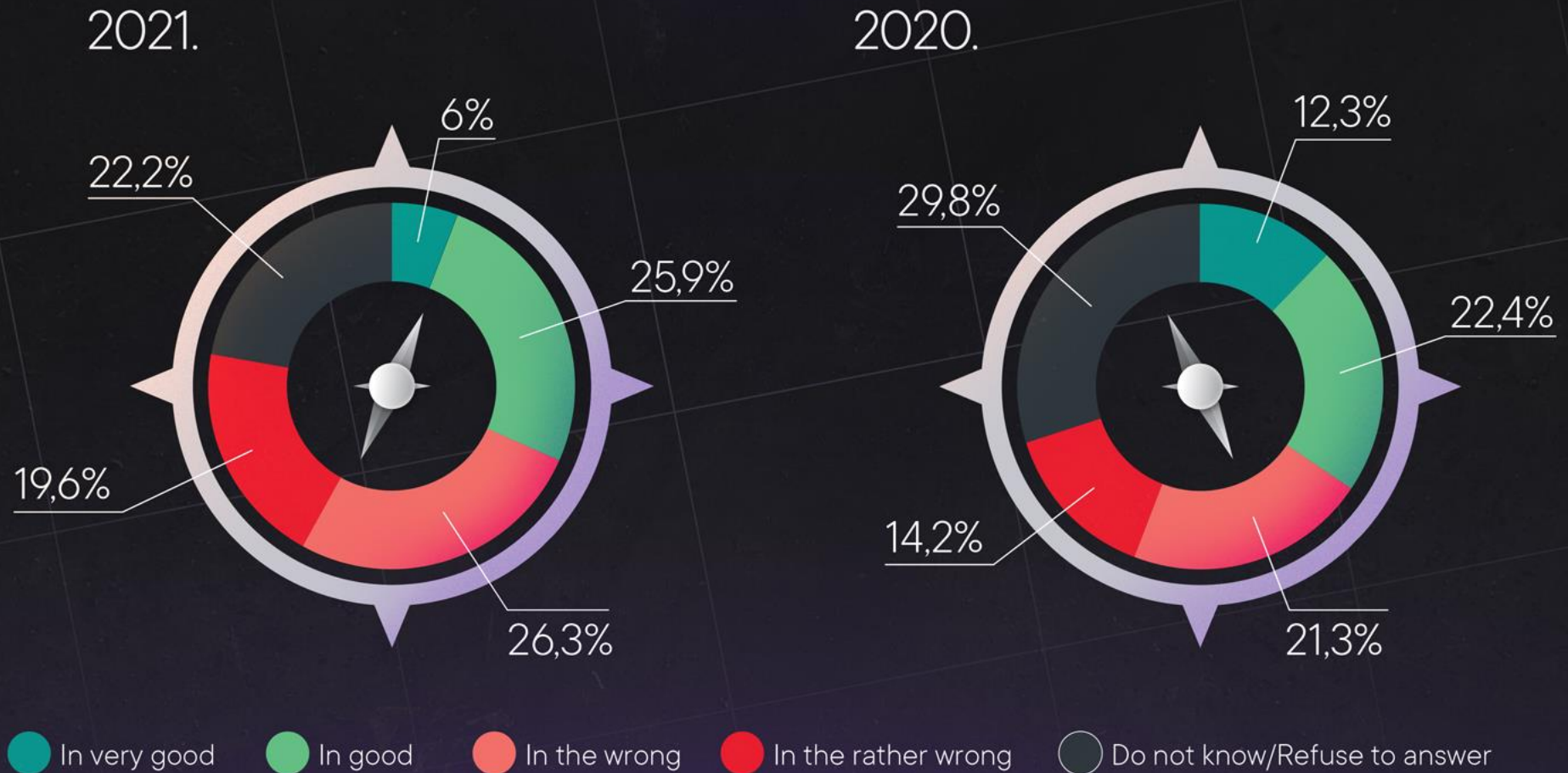

# Methodology

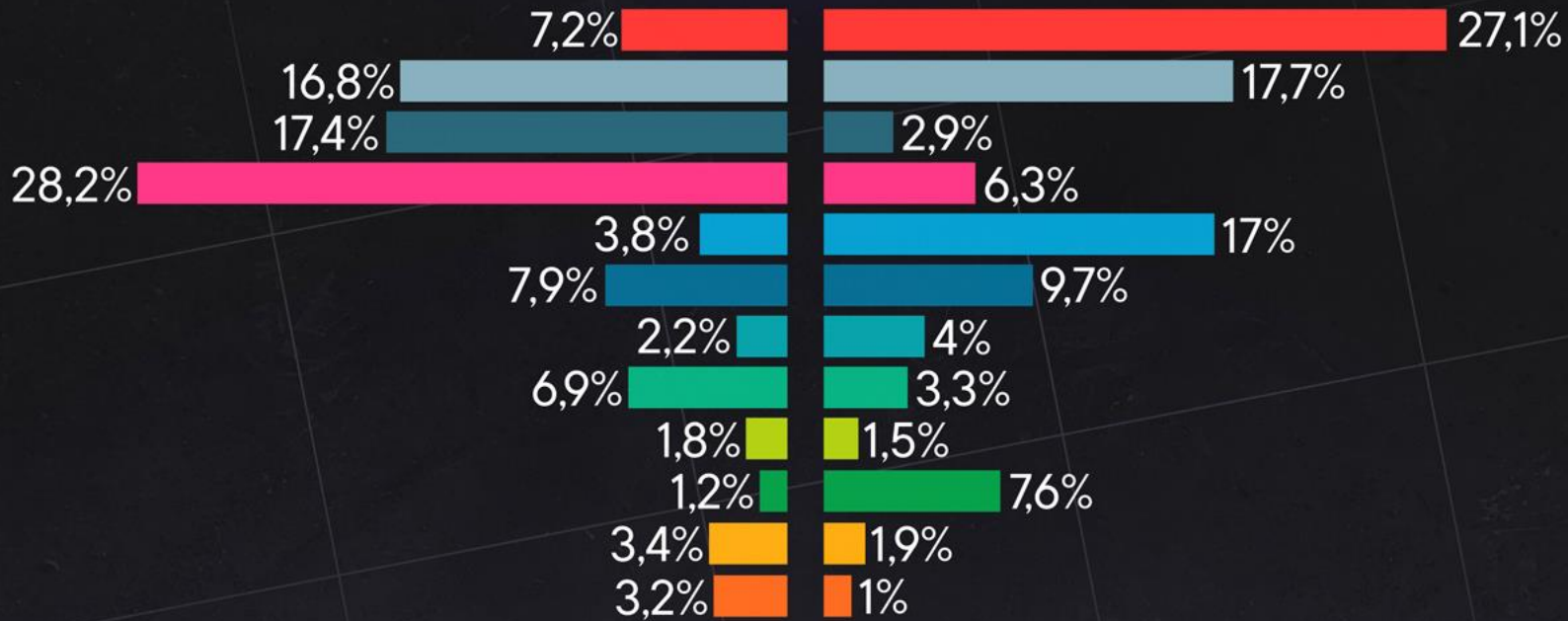
<b>Performance:</b>	Data collection performed in the period from 1 to 15 October 2021.

	Second stage: Household by the method of random selection
	Third stage: Household member by birthday method
<b>Research type:</b>	Omnibus – CAPI

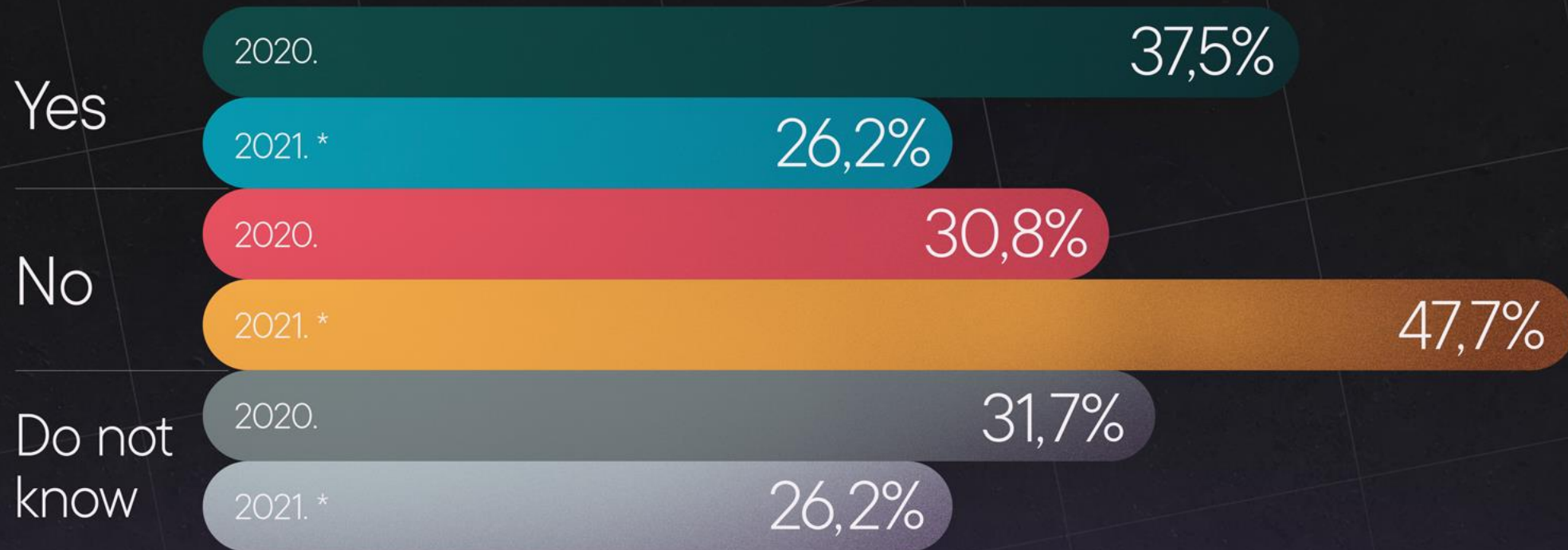

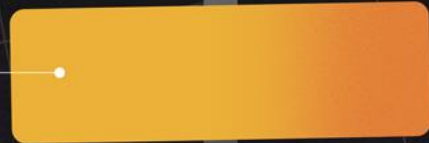

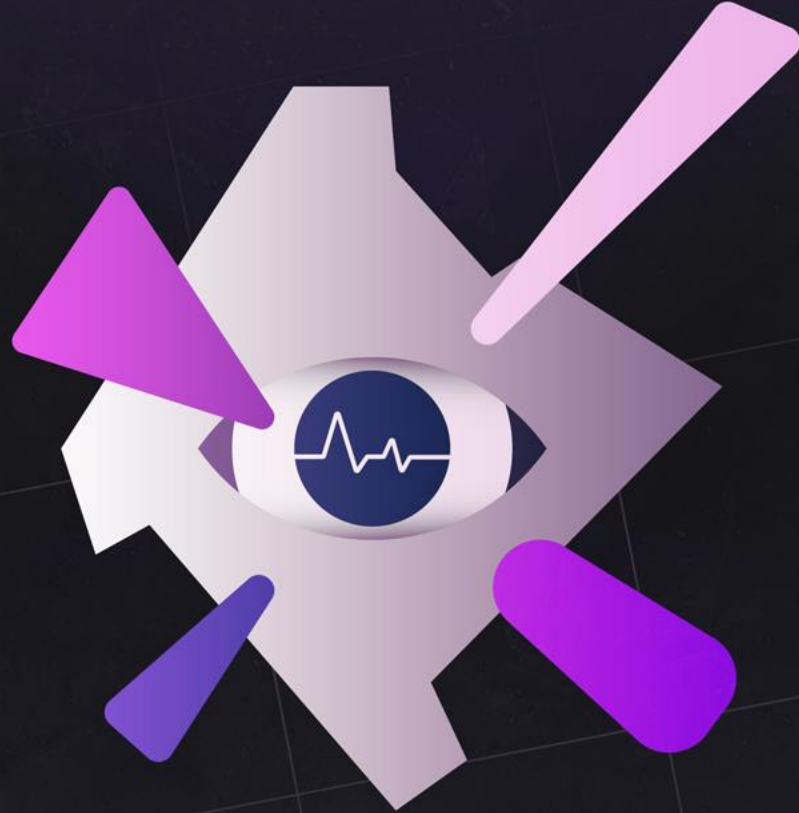
