








How would you describe the character of this Government?






In your opinion, which of the signatories of the Agreement (Krivokapić, Bečić, Abazović) respected the principles set out in the Agreement the most?








Who determines the policy and activities of the Government of Montenegro the most?






Have you heard of the "Marshall Plan - Europe Now" programme of the Government of Montenegro?




Do you believe in the feasibility of the "Marshall Plan - Europe Now" programme?








What is your opinion on the decision of the Government to register the Cetinje Monastery in the Cadastre as the property of the Serbian Orthodox Church (SOC)?






