









Research type:	Omnibus – CAPI






In which direction is Montenegro moving?







How would you describe the dynamics of change after a year of work of this Government, and a year and a half since the establishment of the new parliamentary majority?








When considering your household's total income, do you think that your household can 'make ends meet', or more precisely - to pay their necessary expenses?











In your opinion, what is the purpose of this Memorandum?





Who is responsible for the fact that today we do not have a Prosecutorial Council in full capacity?








When voting in the Parliament, MPs should be guided by ...



Public interest, i.e. what is best for citizens and in line with EU recommendations, regardless of how other MPs vote




