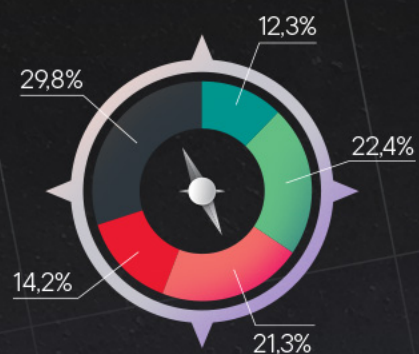

<b>Research type:</b>	Omnibus – CAPI

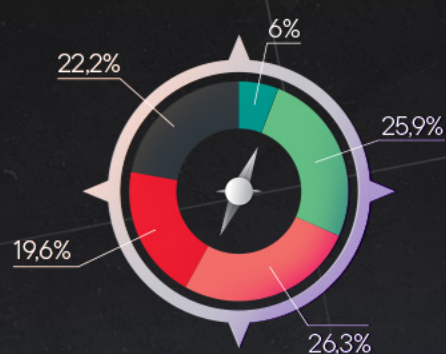

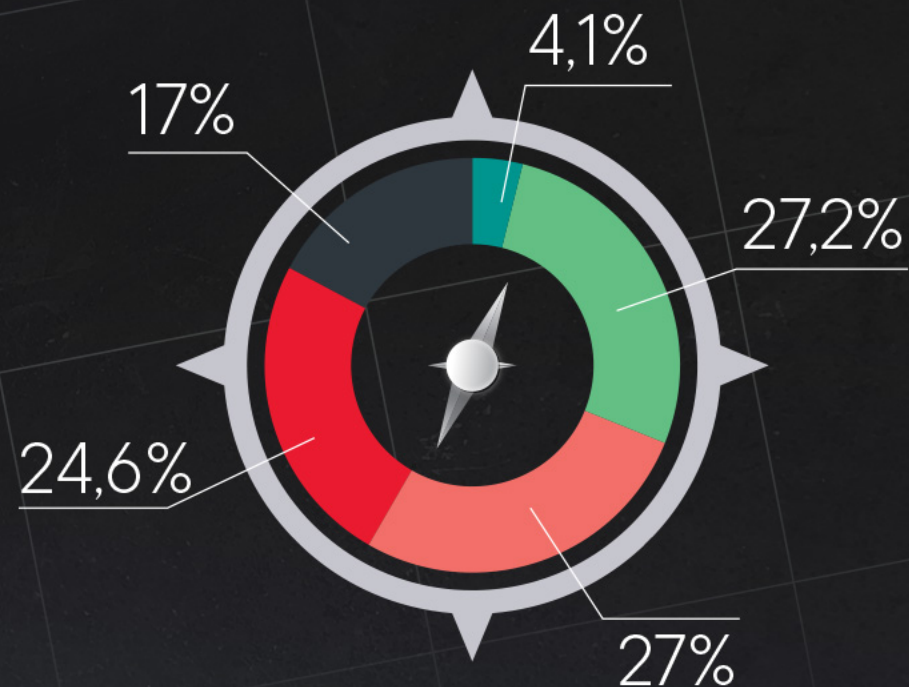

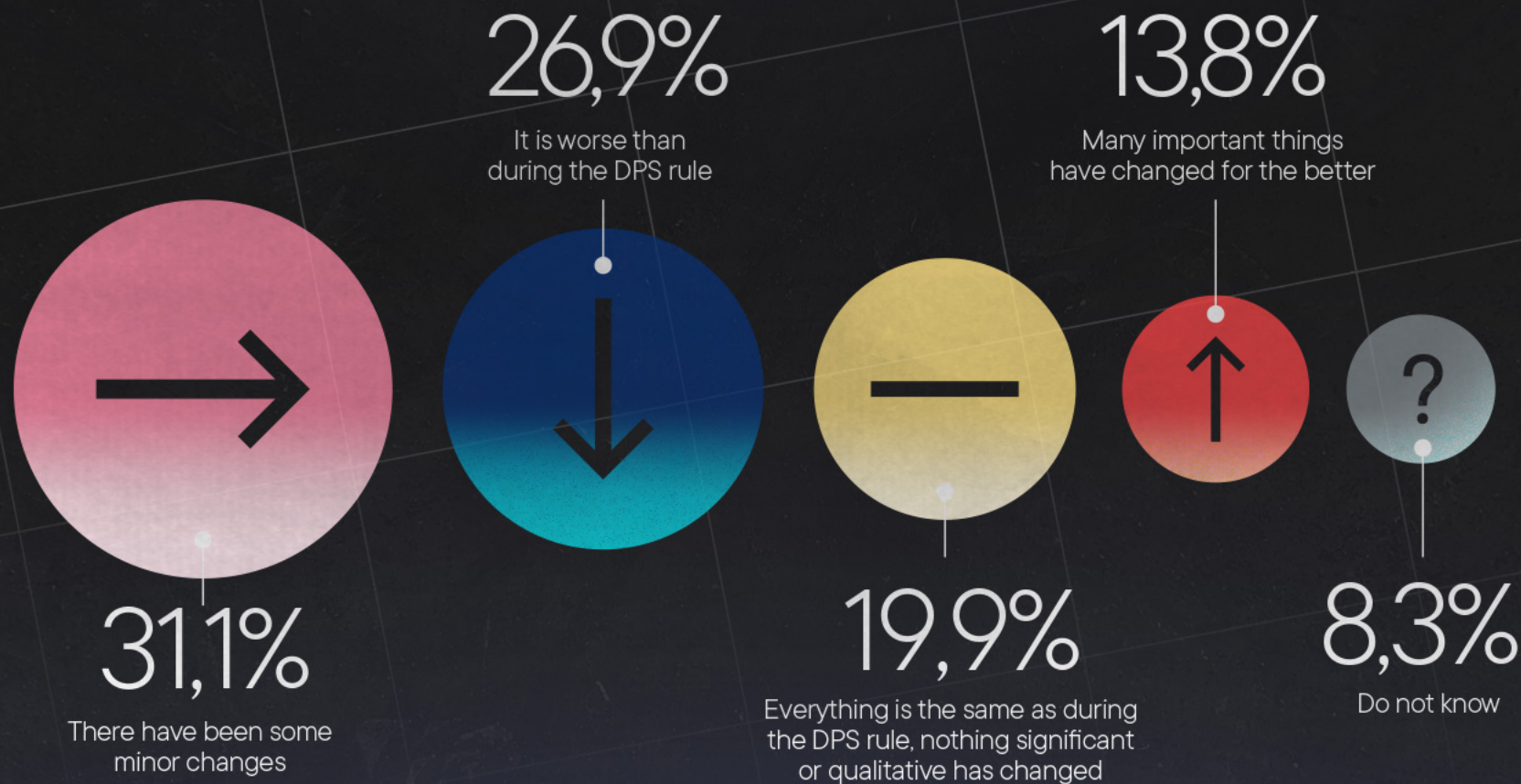

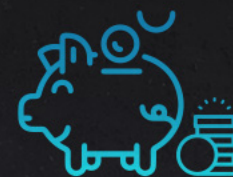

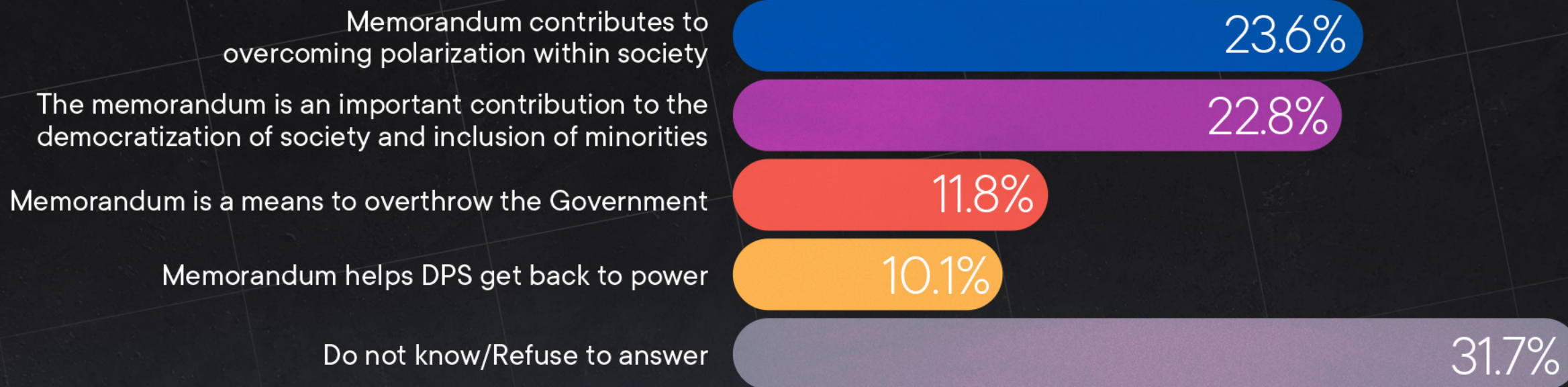

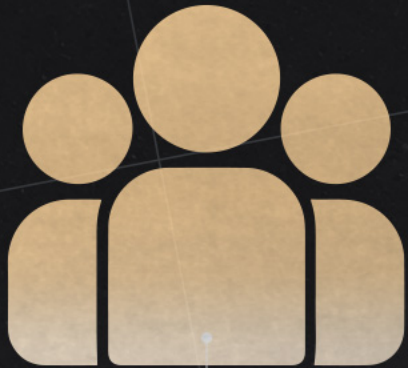

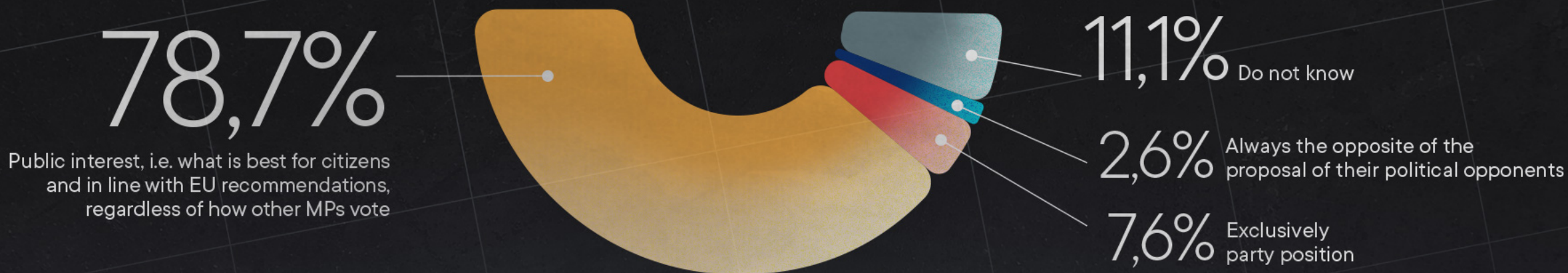

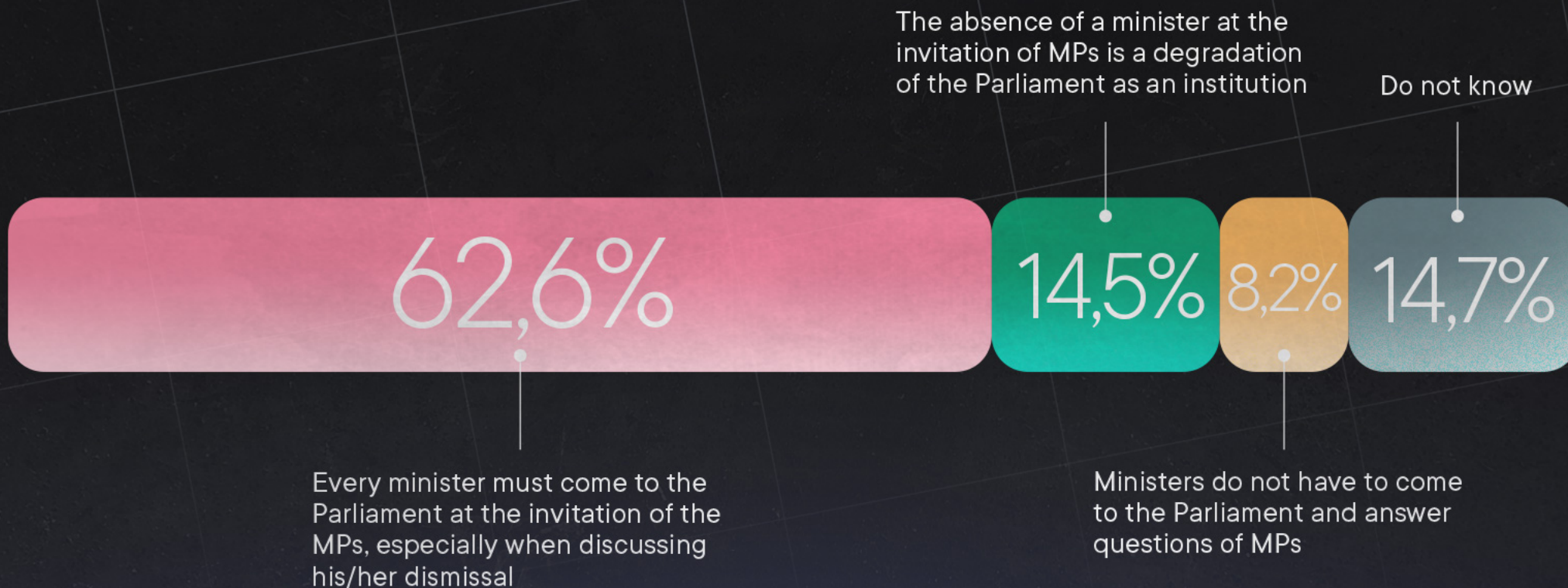


## When voting in the Parliament, MPs should be guided by ...
