


Performance:	Data collection performed from 17 to 23 February 2022

Research type:	Omnibus – CAPI







Early elections

Should the government of Zdravko Krivokapić organise elections?








Do you support the programme - Europe now?







Do you consider the current salary increase realistic and sustainable?






Have the prices of food and the cost of living increased?






Do you know someone who lost a job because the employer couldn't pay new minimum wage?





Do you believe that the new government will continue the Europe now programme?








In your opinion, is the procedure of no-confidence motion against the government of Zdravko Krivokapić implemented in a democratic way?








In your opinion, was the dismissal of the president of the parliament Aleksa Bečić conducted in a democratic manner?








Do you support the abolition of special fees for officials?
