

#### In which direction is Montenegro moving?













#### What issues currently concern you the most?
















What is your opinion on Montenegro's joining restrictive measures and sanctions against Russia?




What is your standard of living compared with last year?








In your opinion, does the minority Government have the capacity to successfully face the current and expected economic and social problems?
