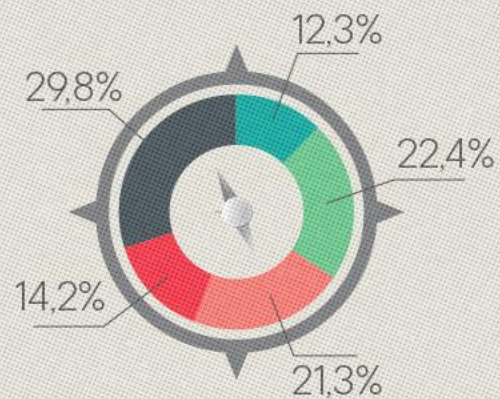

<b>Research type:</b>	CAPI



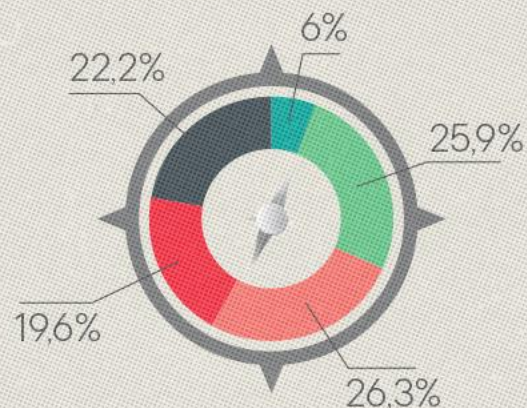

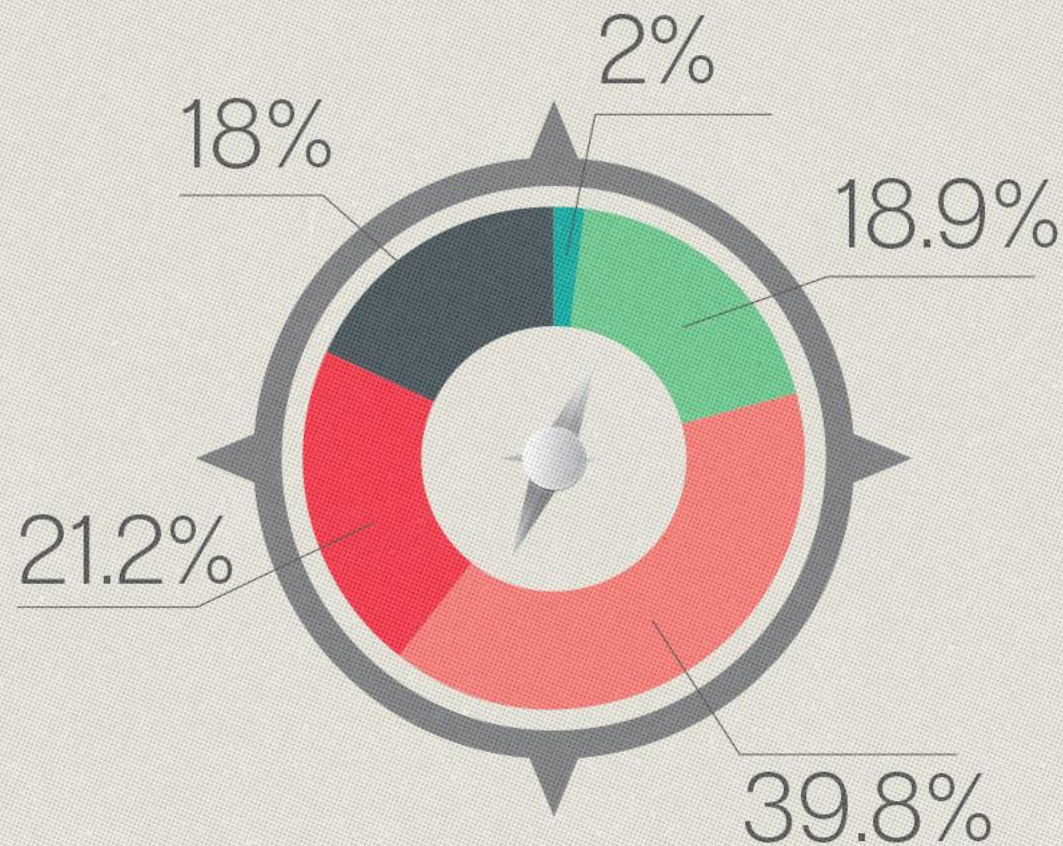

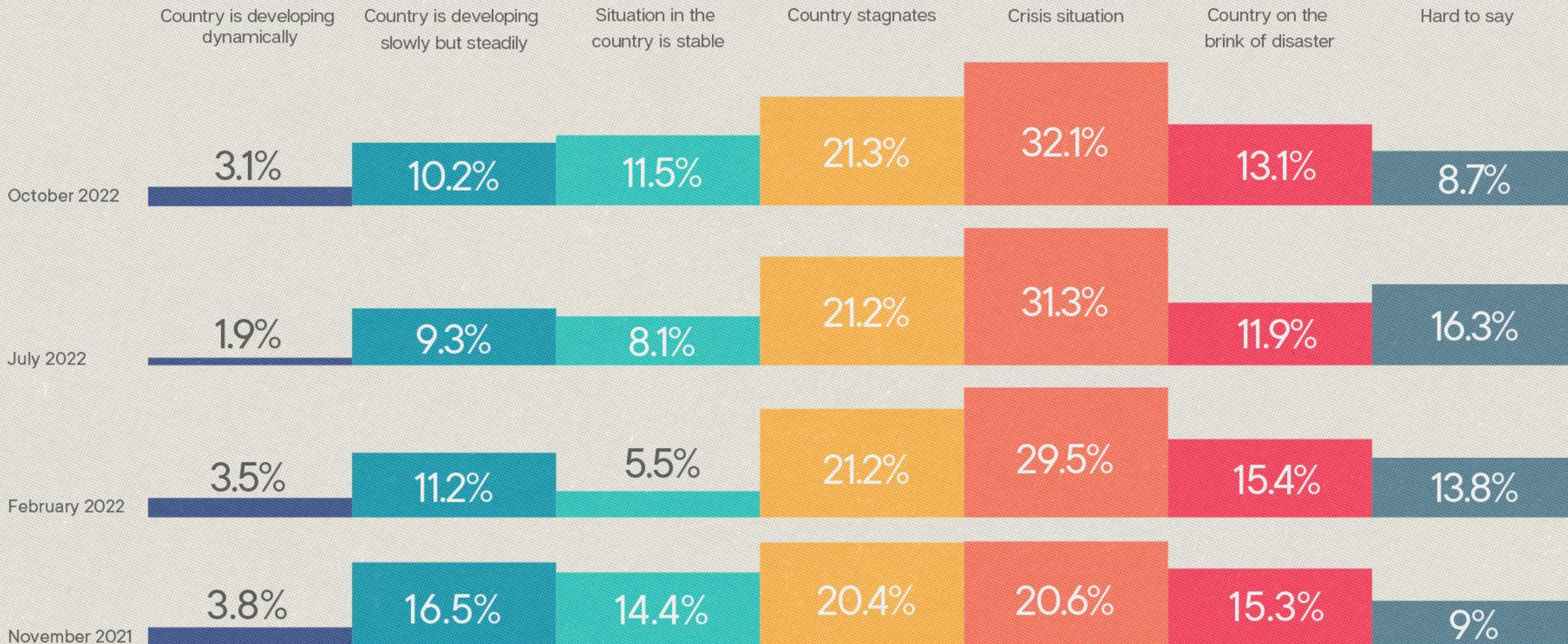

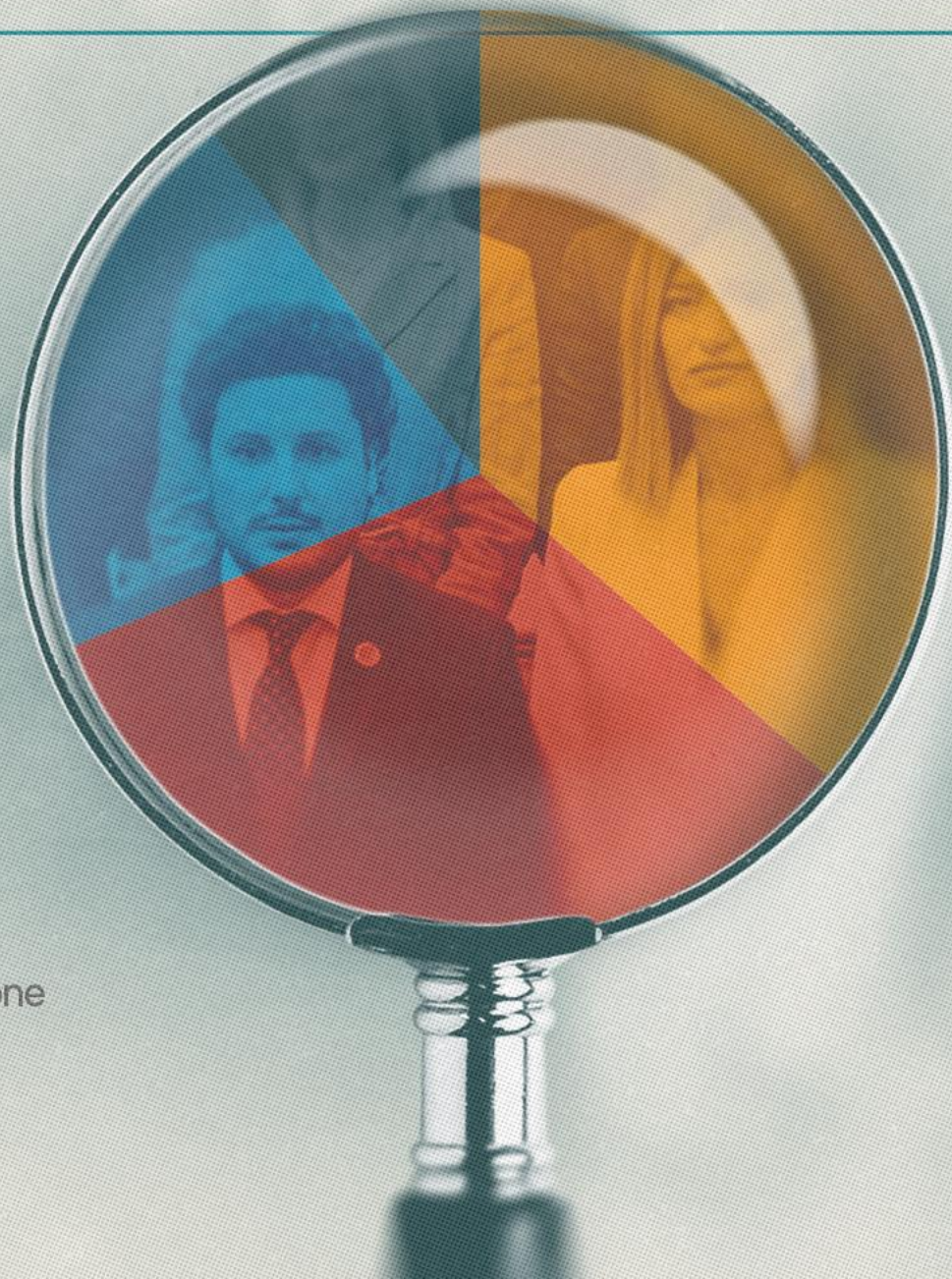
How do you assess the transparency of work of the current Government?

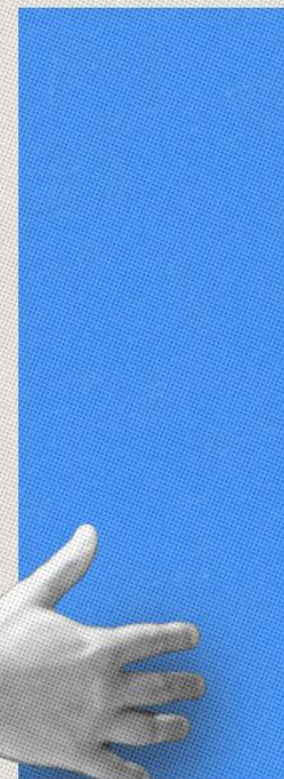

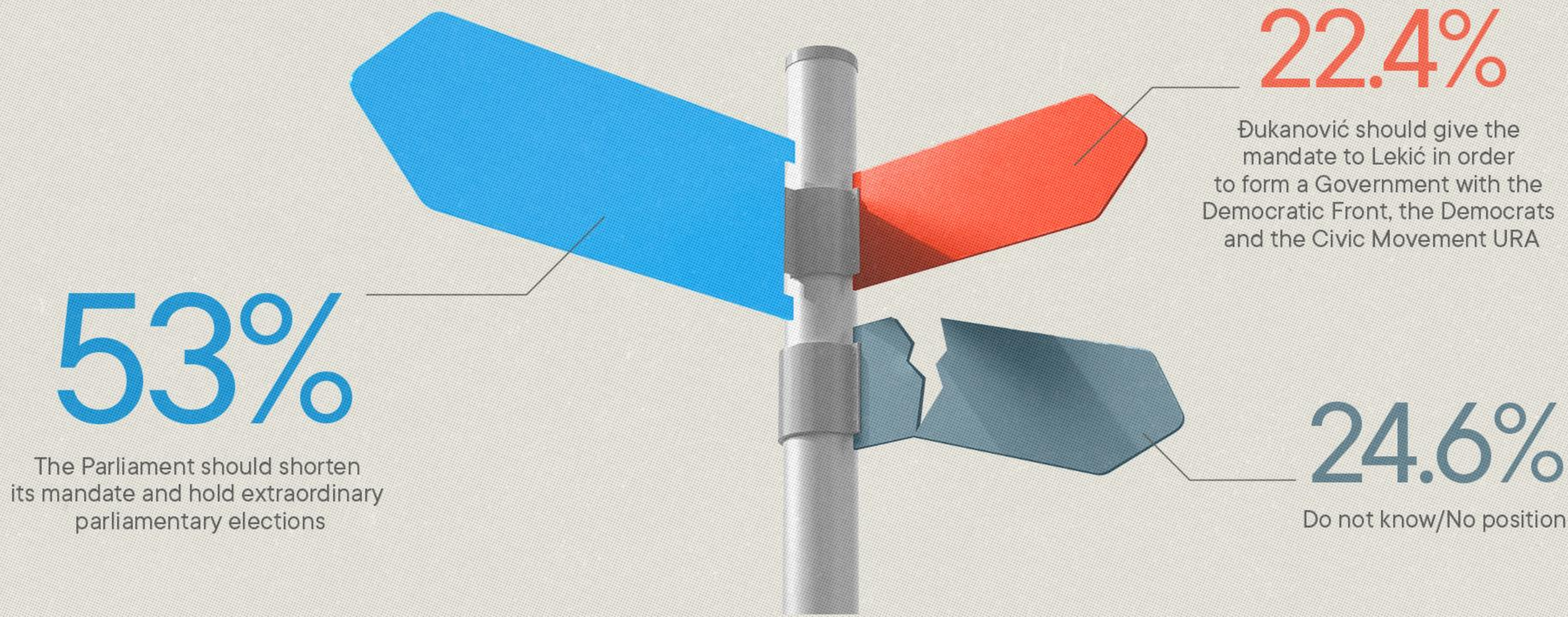

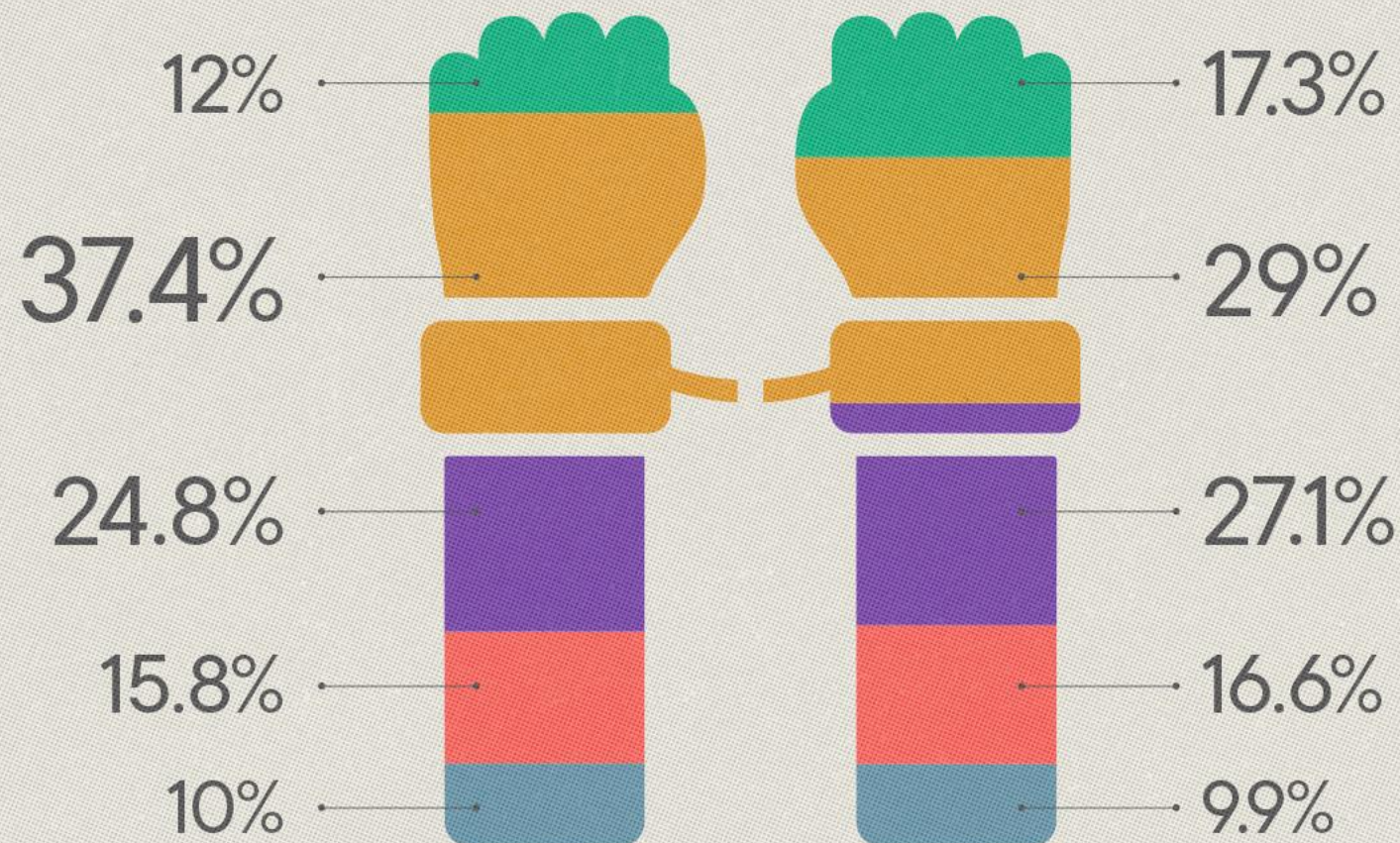


## How do you perceive the last arrests and detentions in Montenegro?

Do you believe that the new chef special prosecutor can initiate procedures against politicians who are suspected of violating the law?

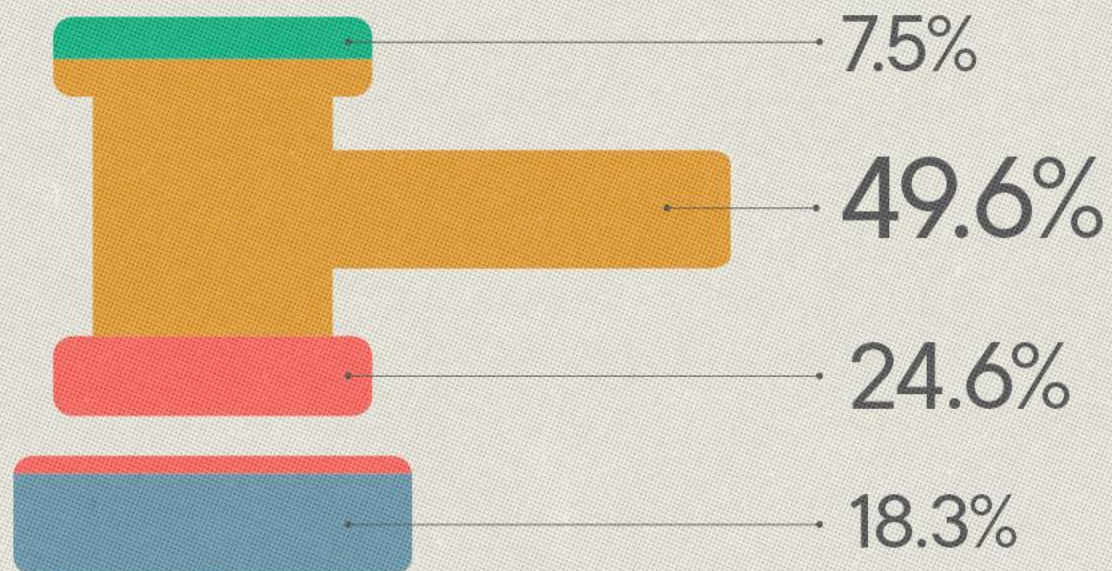
