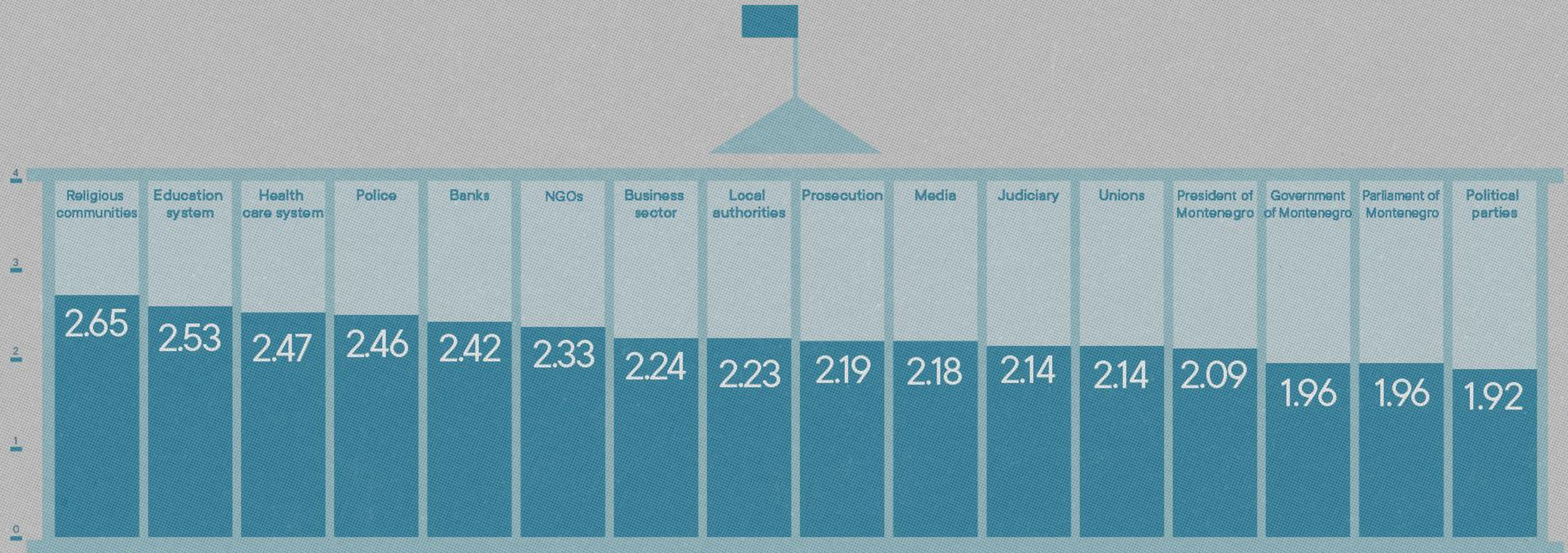
# Methodology

Research type:	CAPI



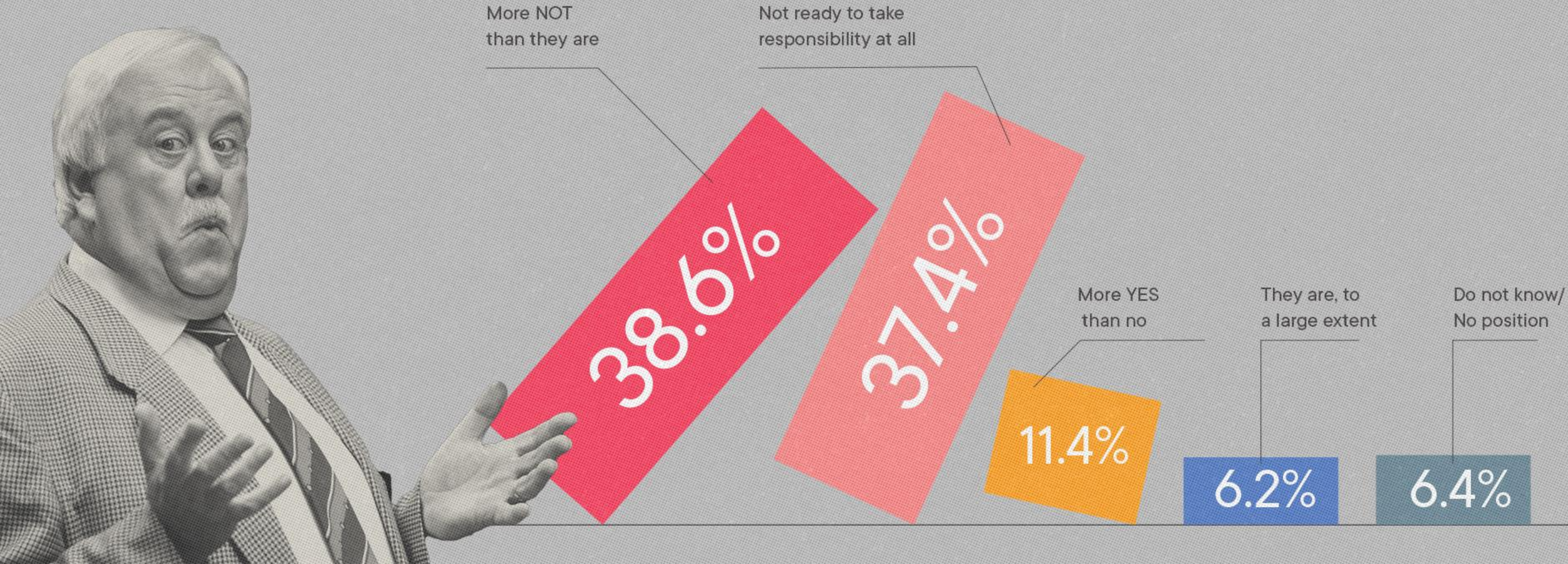
## How much do you trust each of these institutions?

(scale of 1 to 4, 1 - no trust at all, 2 - medium trust, 3 - poor trust, 4 - great trust)



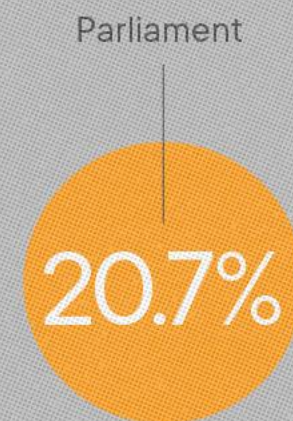


In your opinion, to what extent are politicians in Montenegro generally ready to take responsibility for their actions?

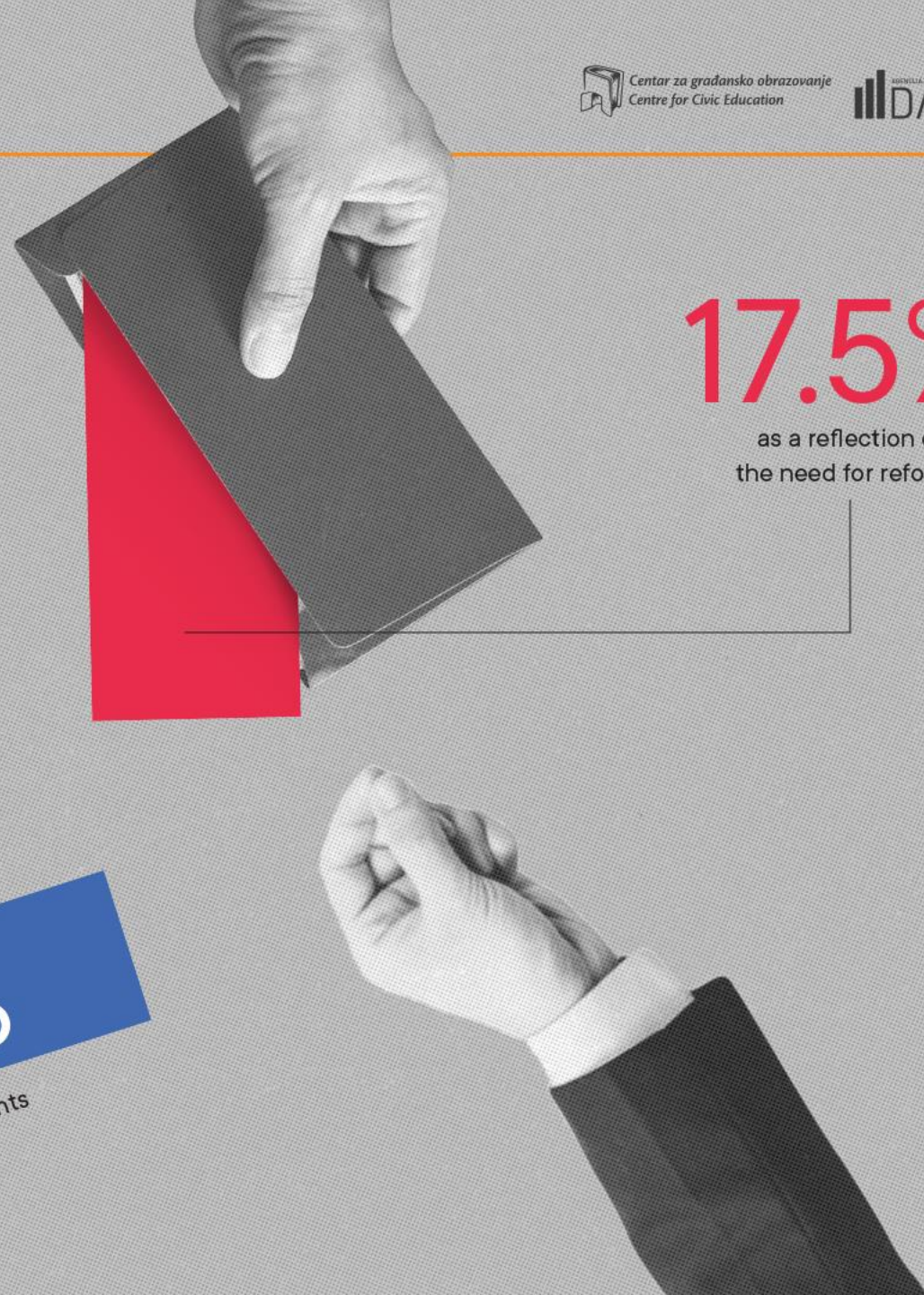

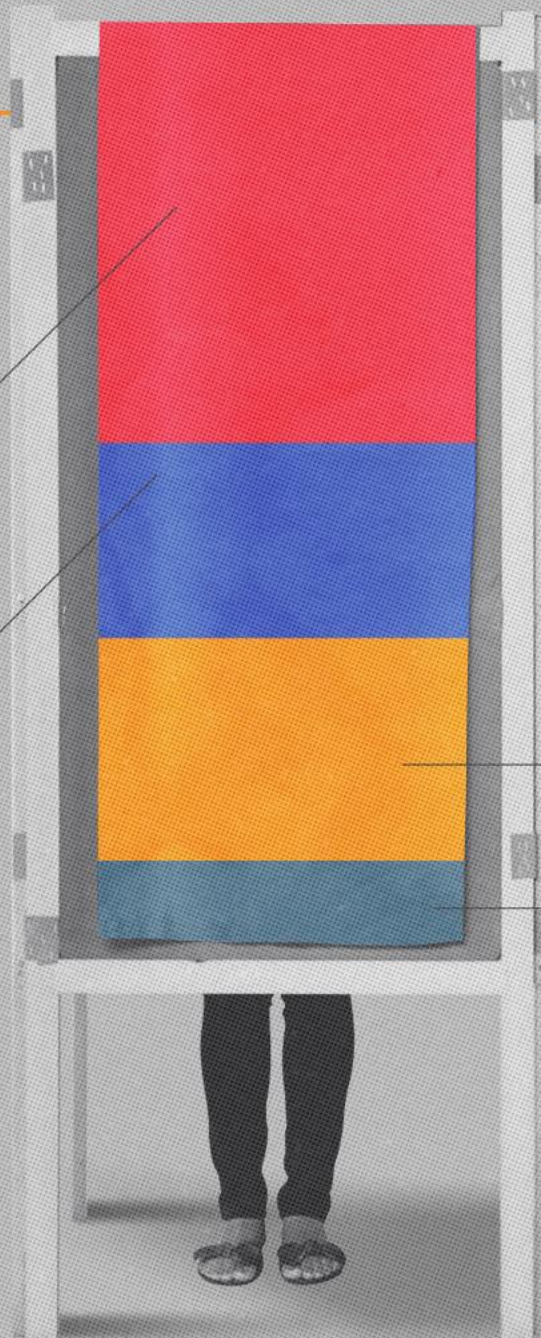

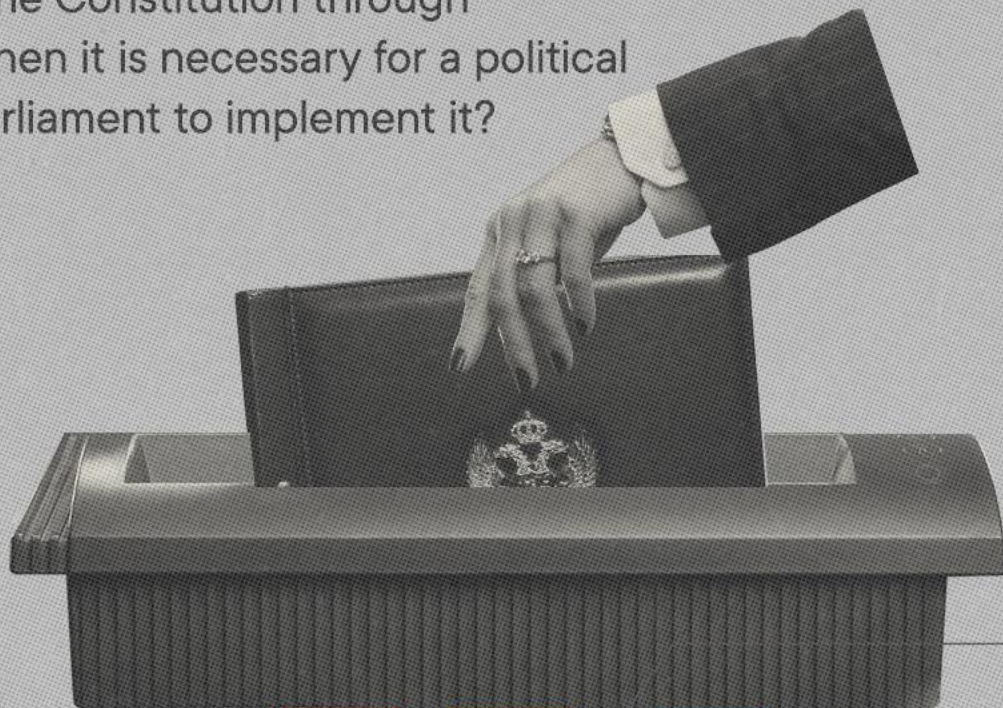

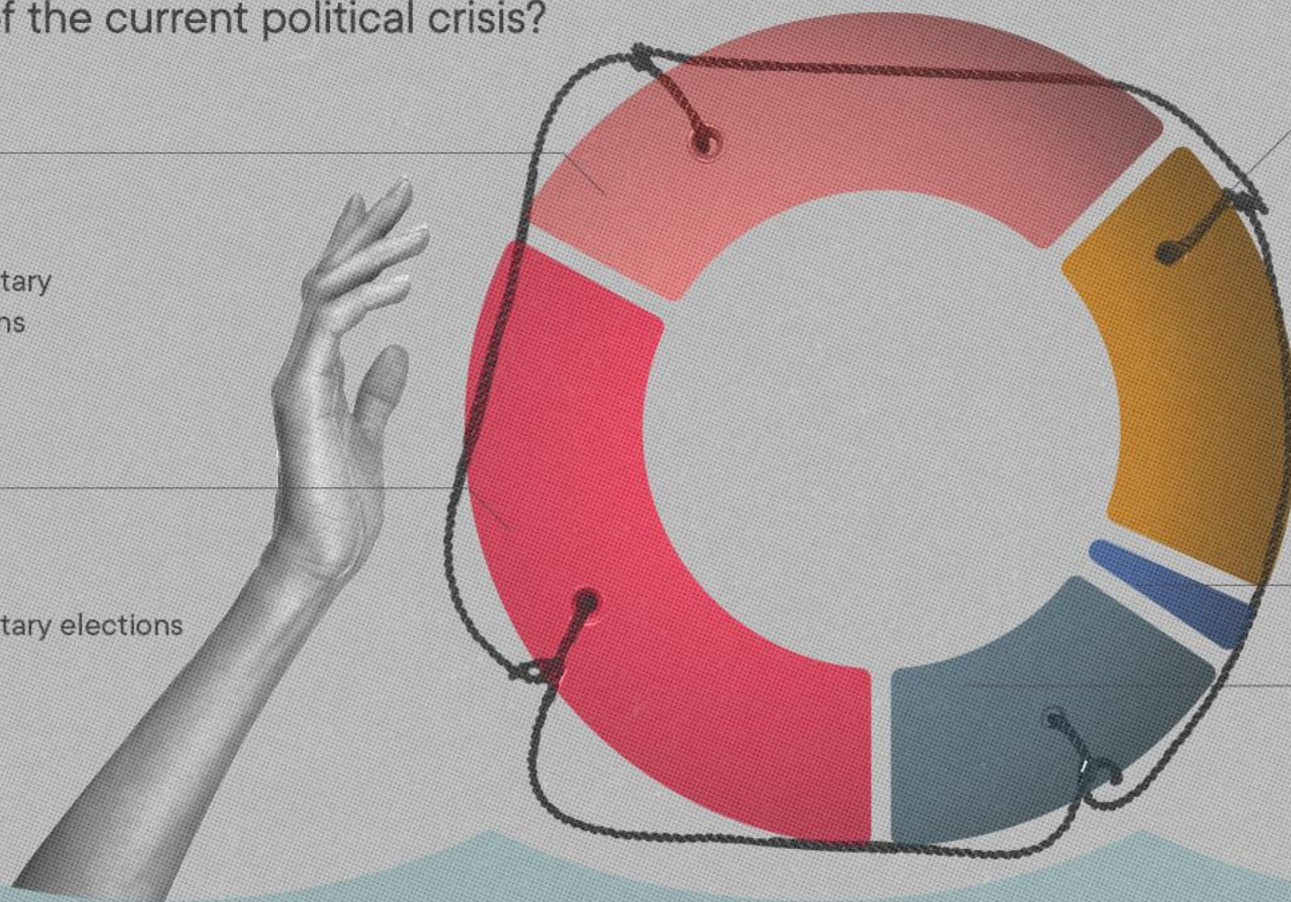

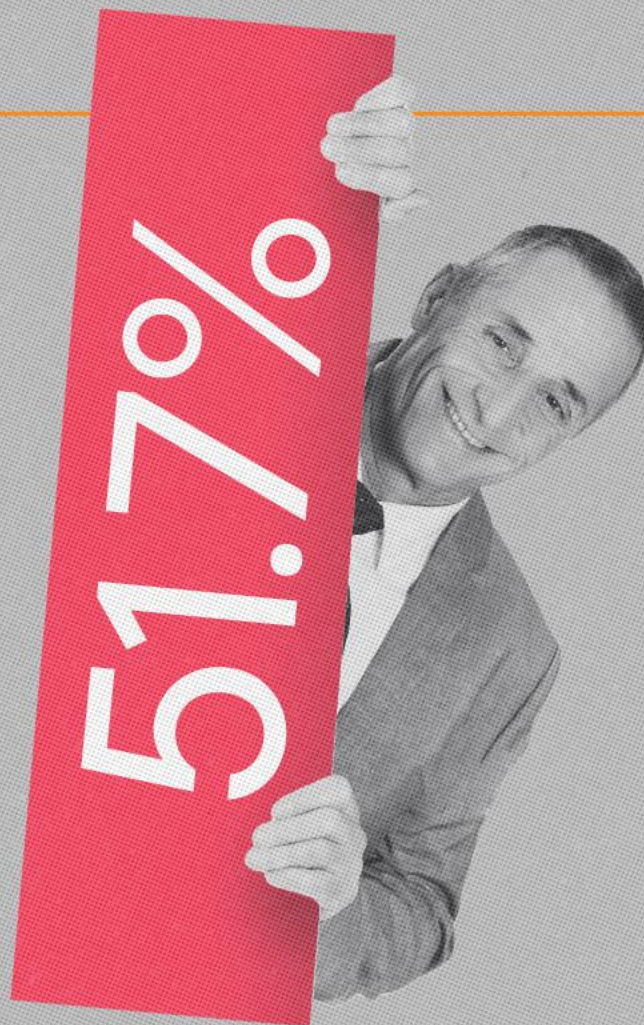

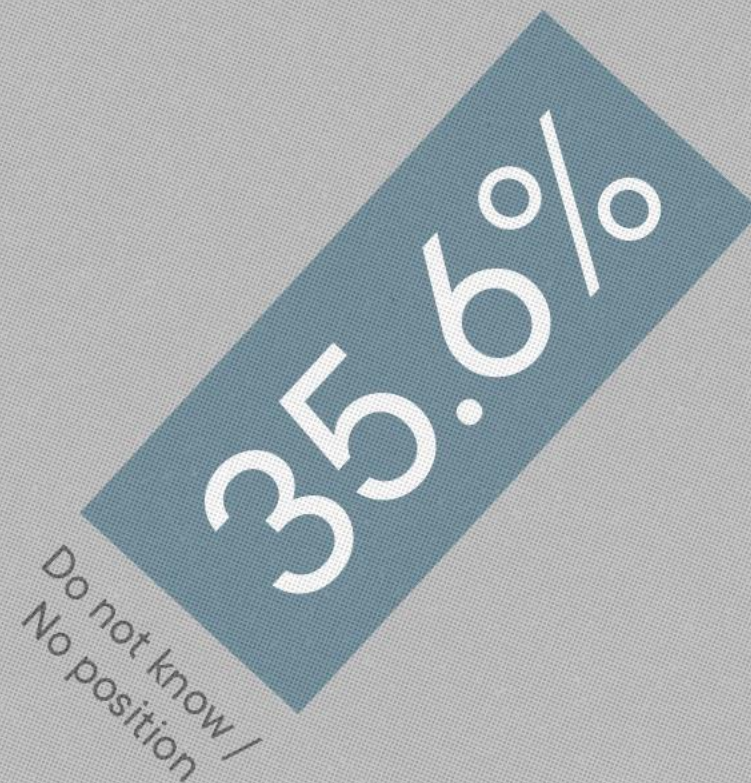

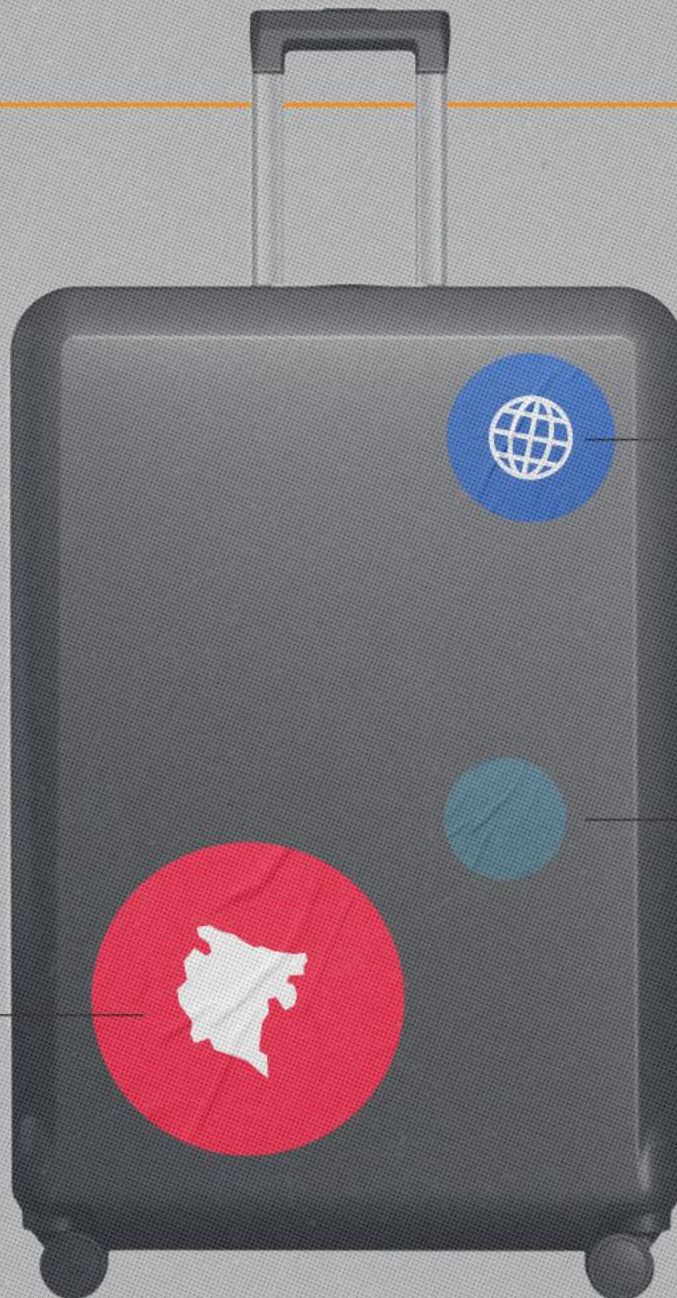

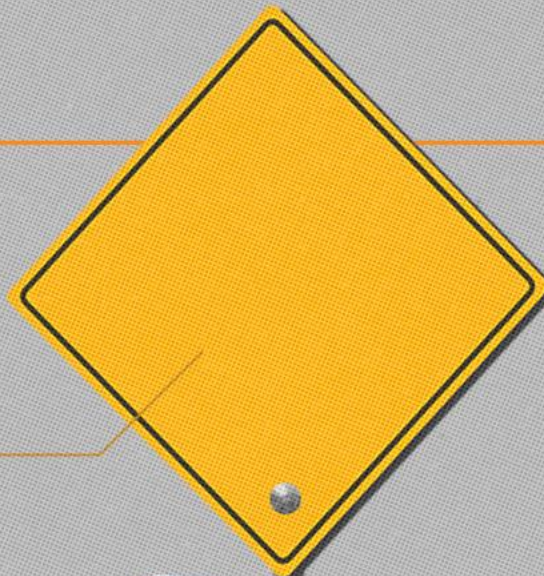

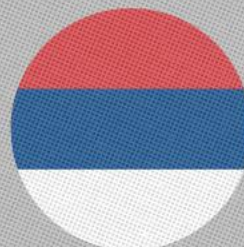

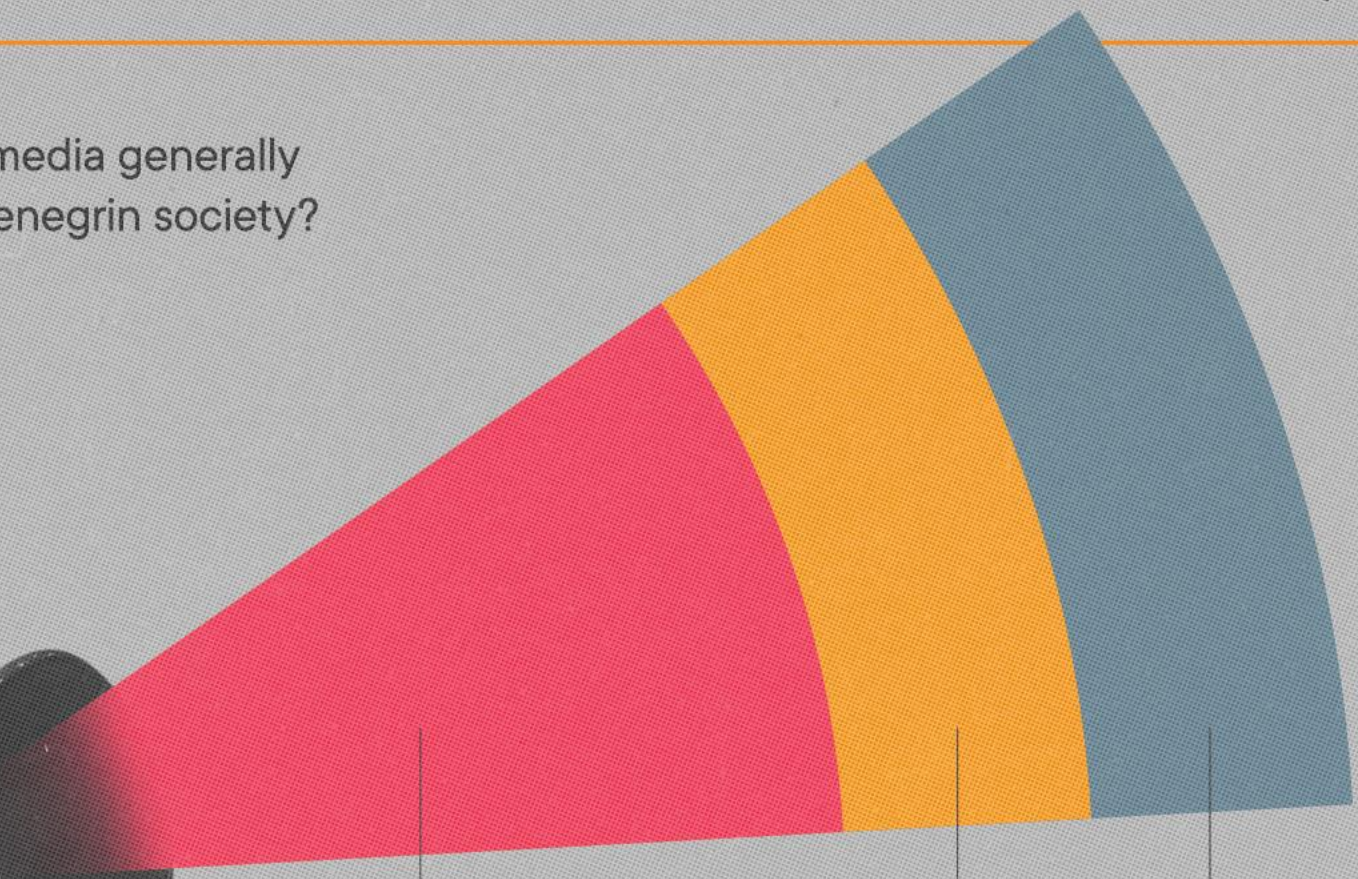


In your opinion, are there objective and independent media in Montenegro?

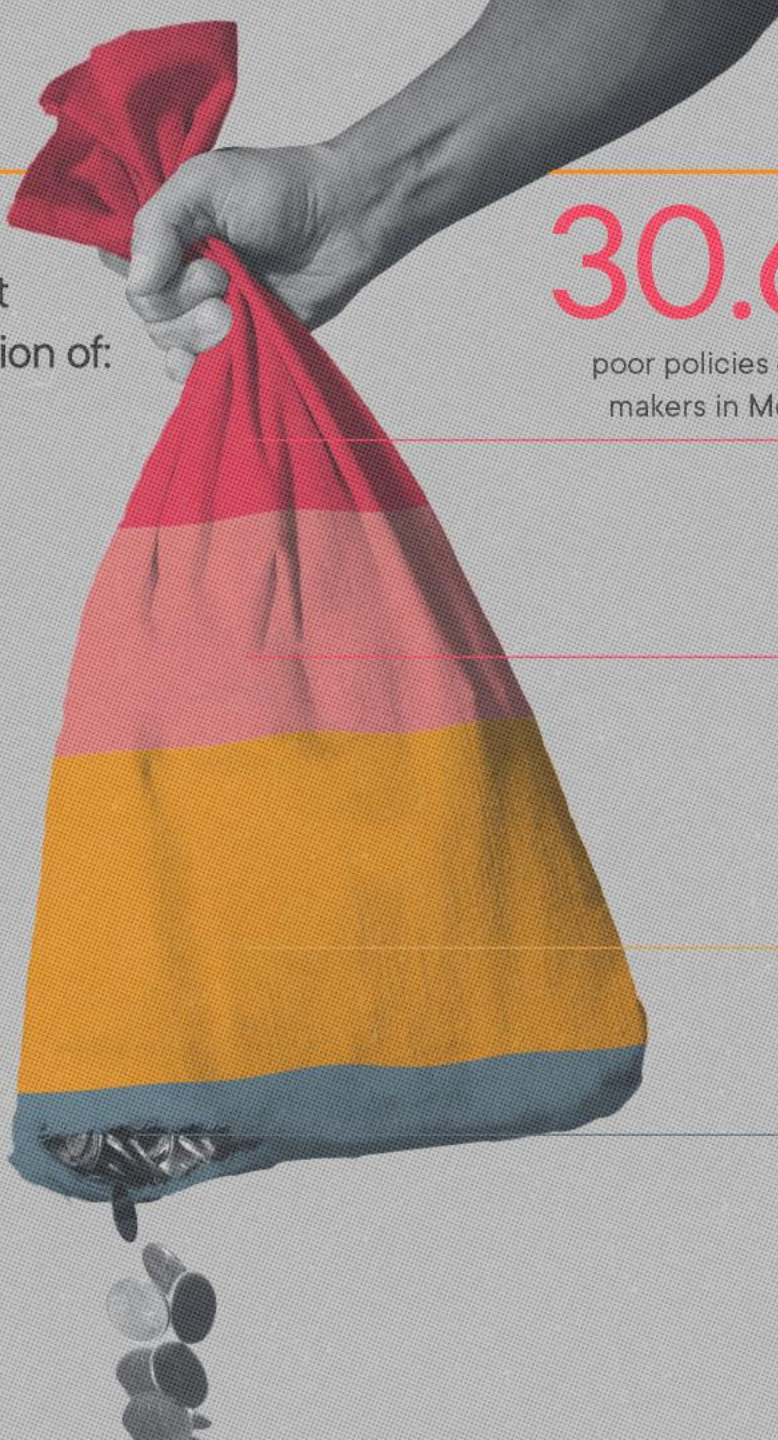
