






#### Who should deal with identity issues in Montenegro?










What position should the new Government have toward the recognition of Kosovo?

- Montenegro should remain in the position of recognizing Kosovo and leave Serbia and Kosovo to resolve their relations



#### Does the state have the same principle toward all tax-payers?




















On a scale of 1 to 5, how would you rate the social dialogue between trade unions, employers and the Government?




What is the quality of teaching staff in Montenegro?












How do you rate the higher education system in Montenegro?














What, in your opinion, harms higher education in Montenegro?










In your opinion, what is the level of health care in Montenegro today?













What are the biggest health problems in Montenegro?




