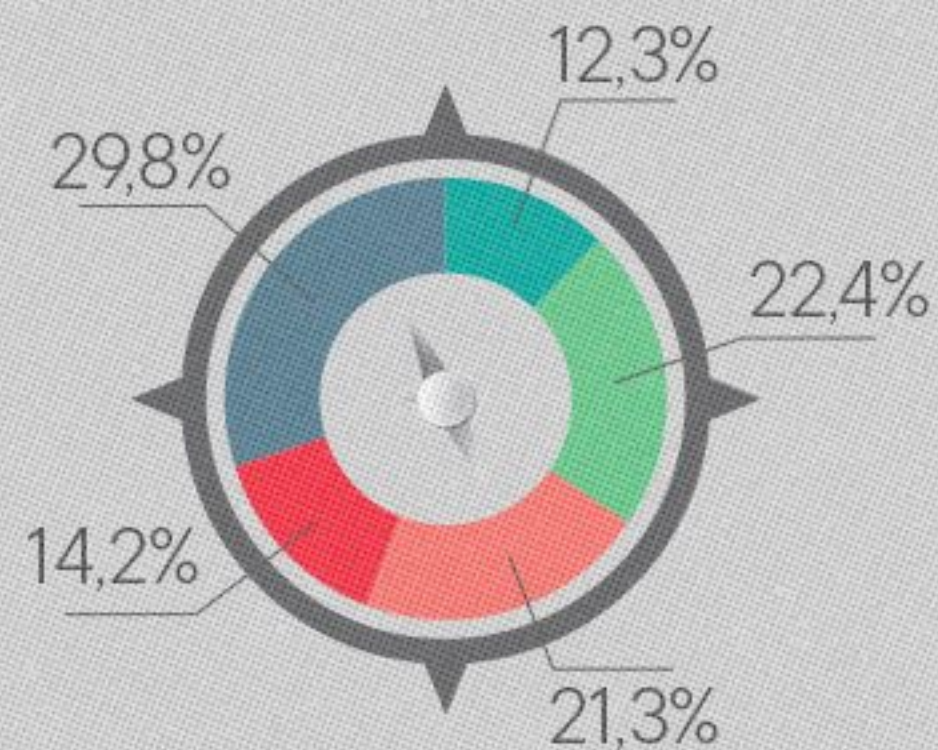

Research type:	CAPI of average duration of 9 minutes

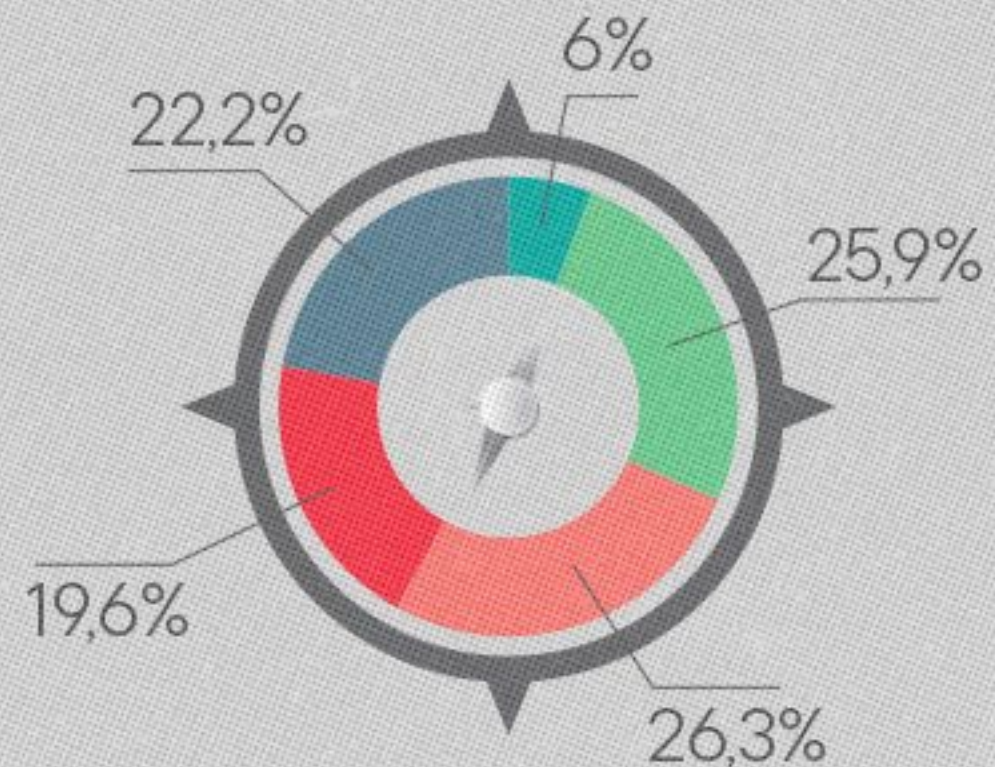


In which direction is Montenegro moving?

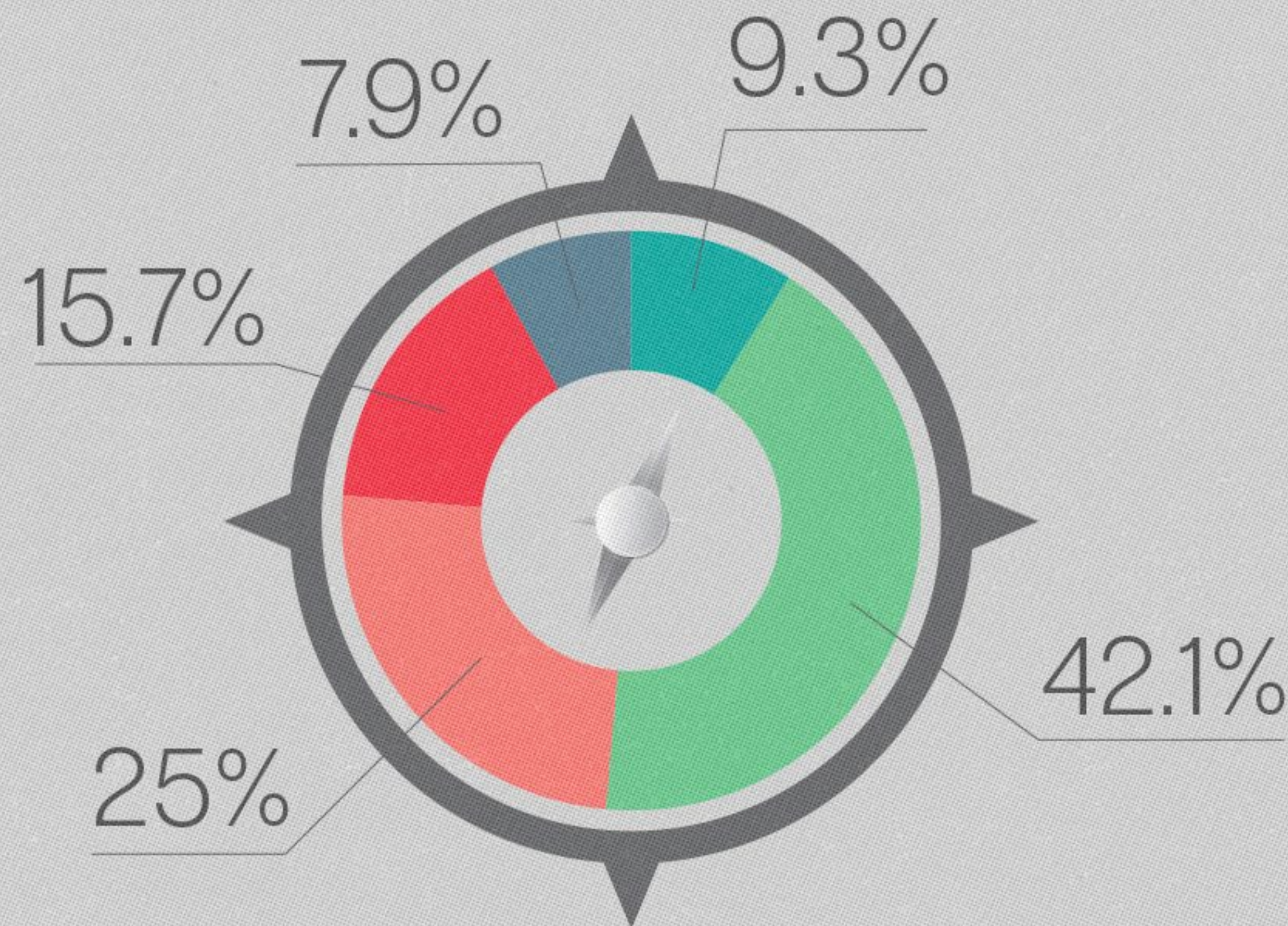

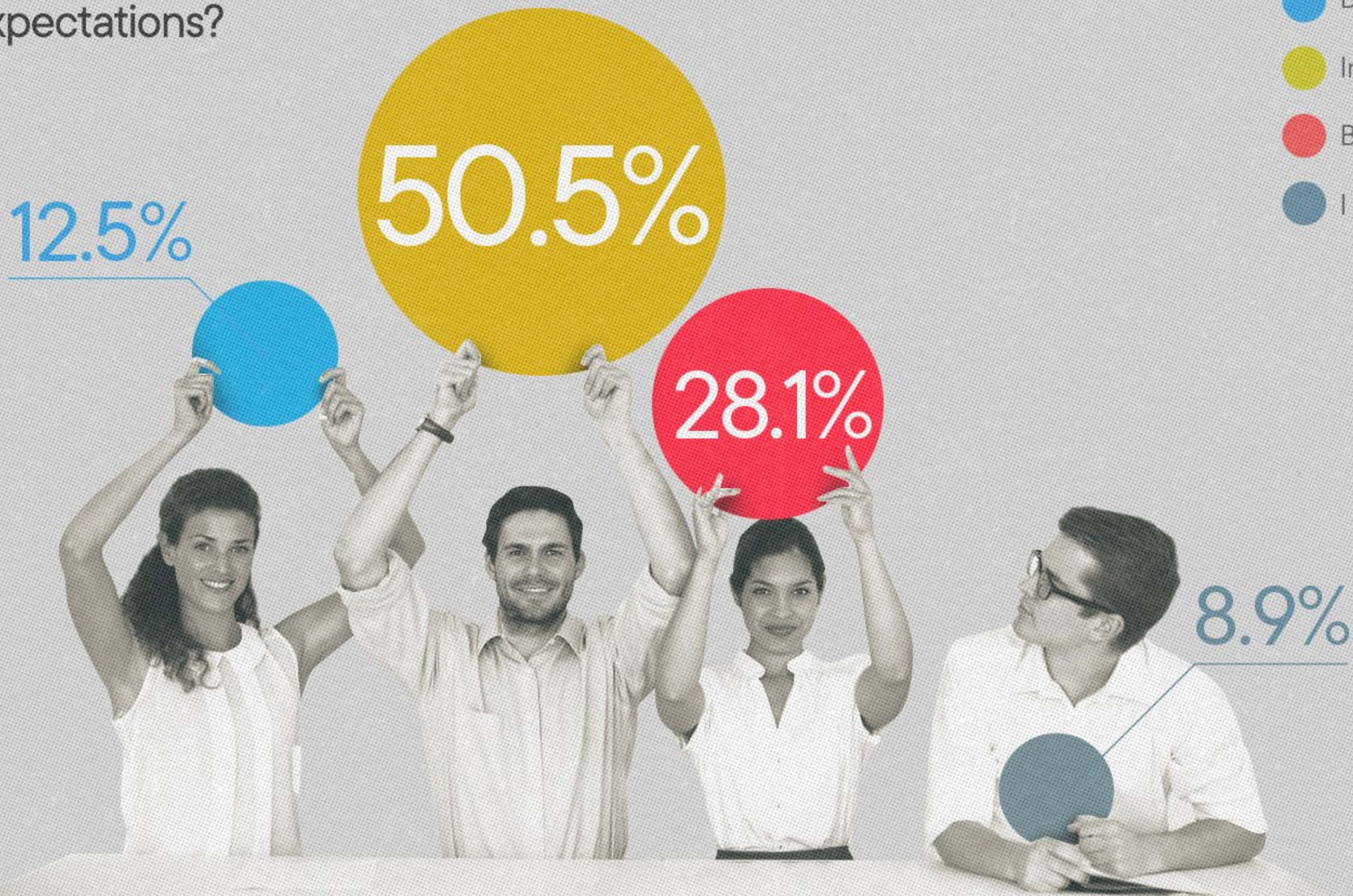

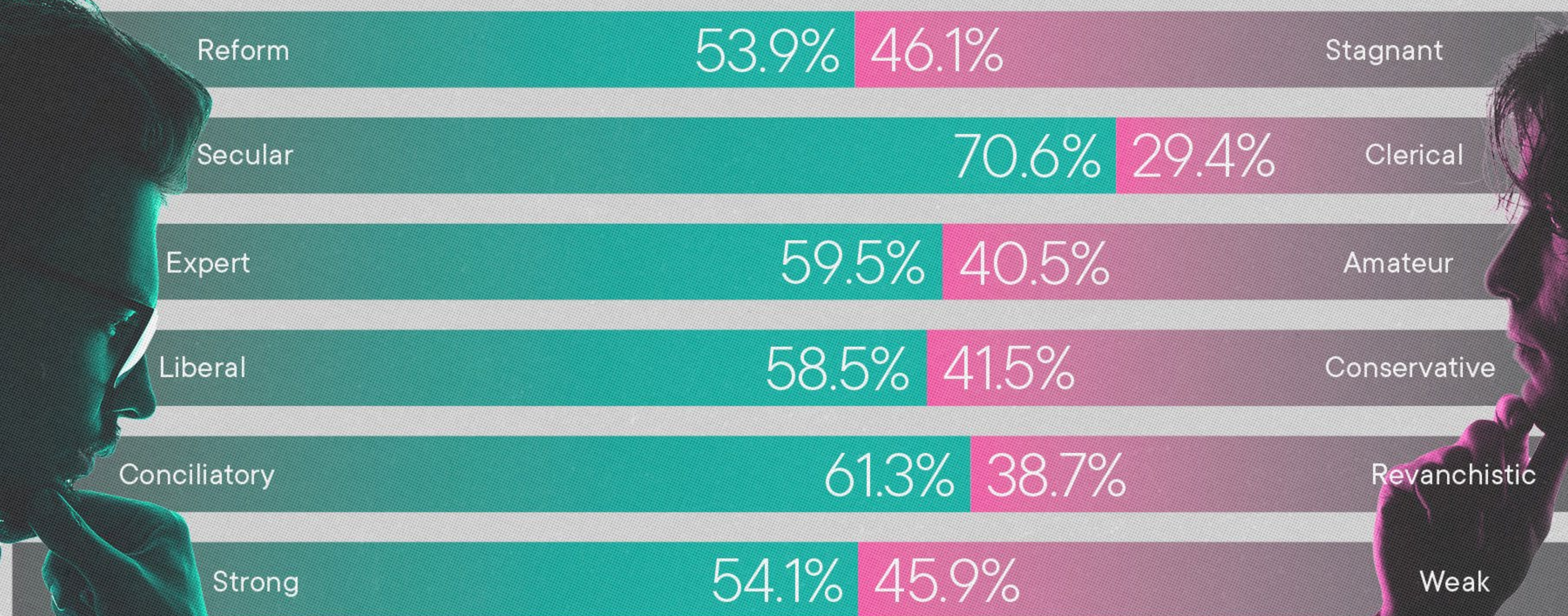

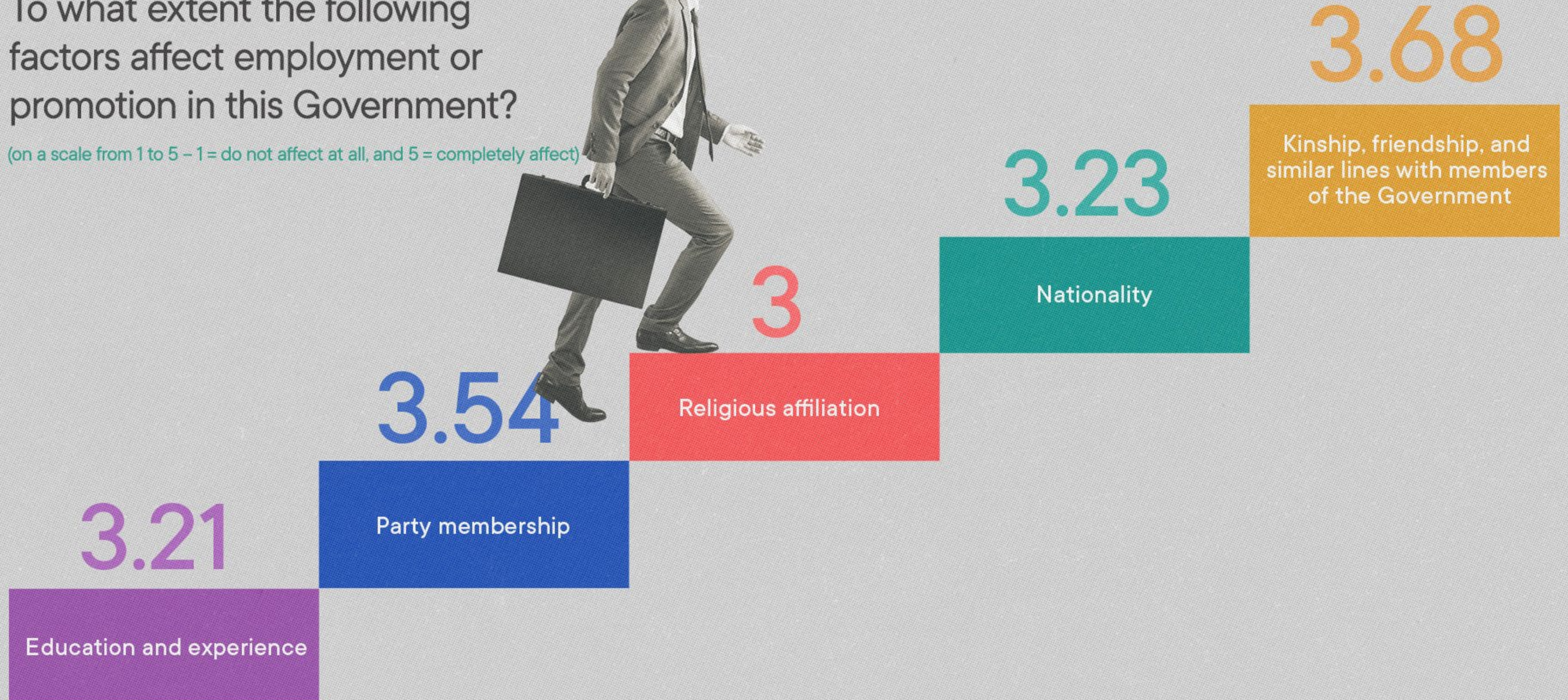
How would you describe the character of this Government?

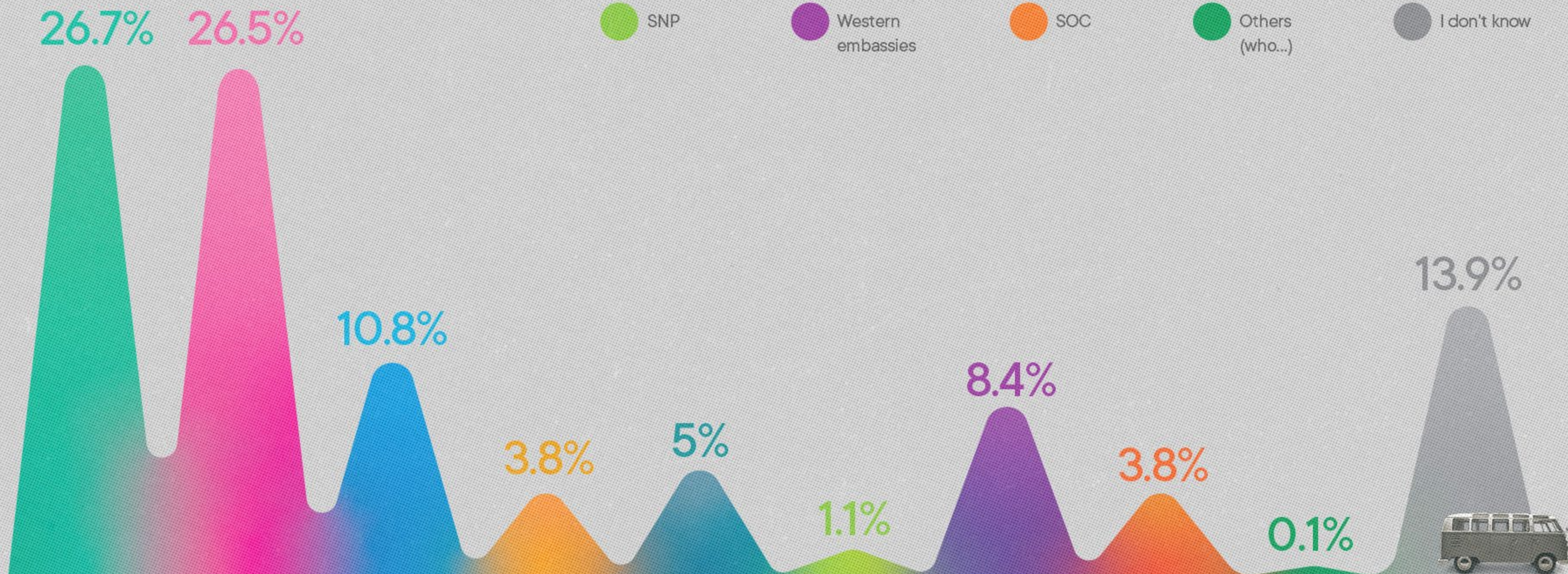
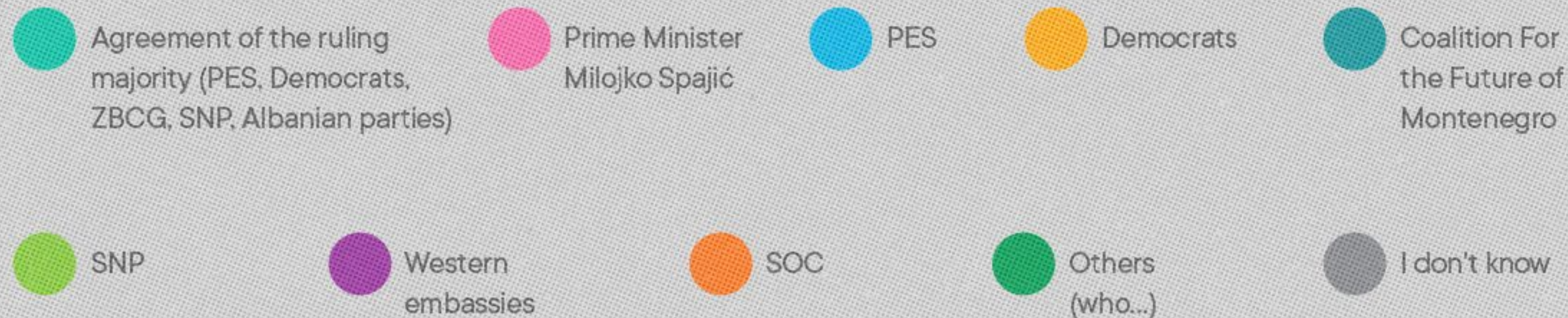

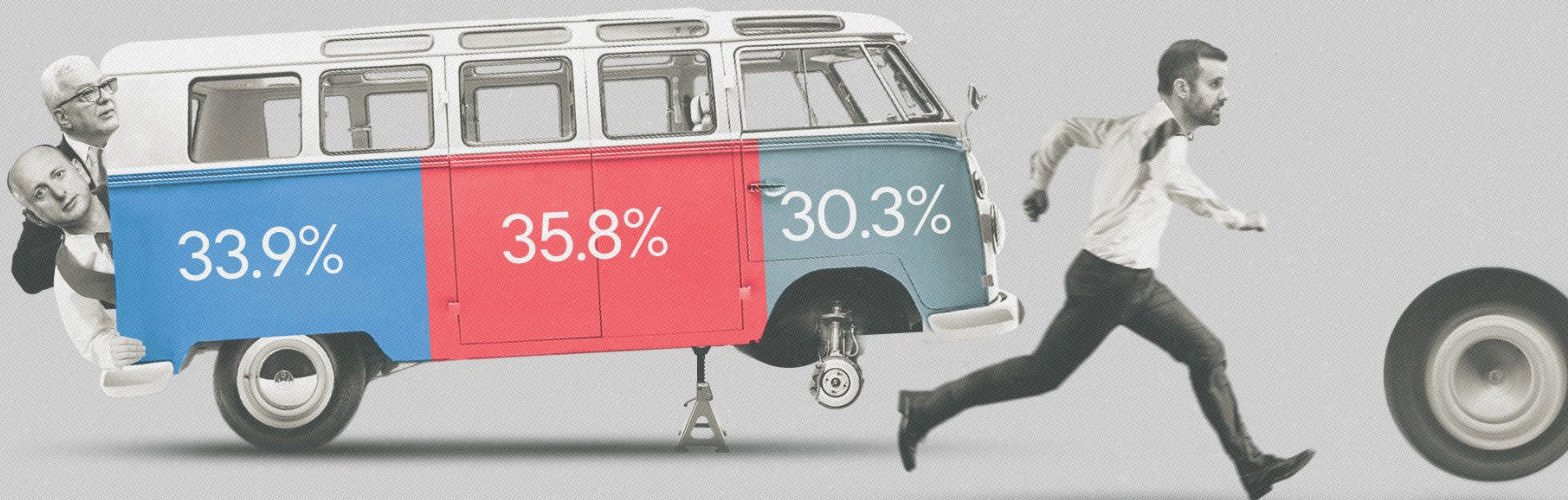
Who largely determines the policy and activities of the Government of Montenegro?

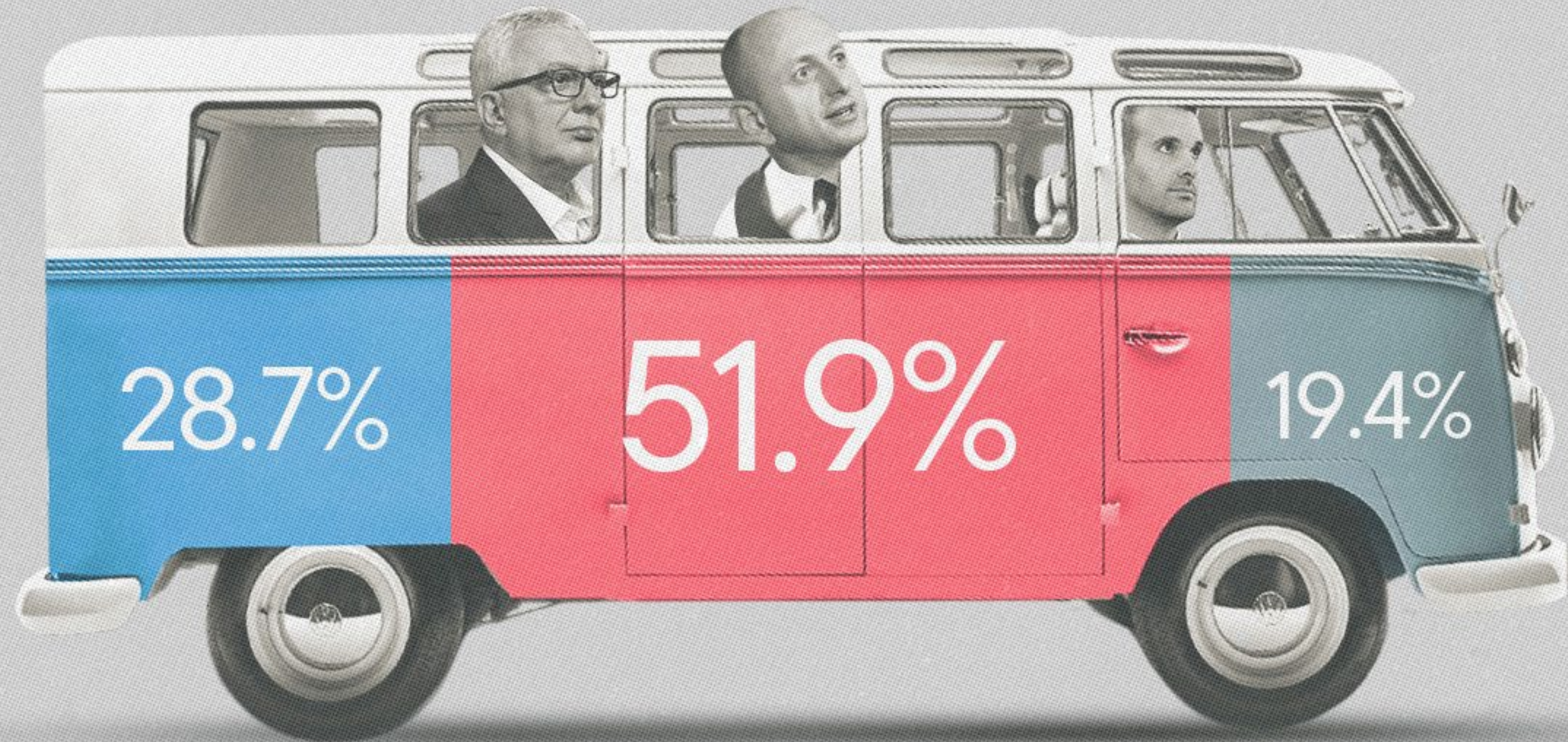

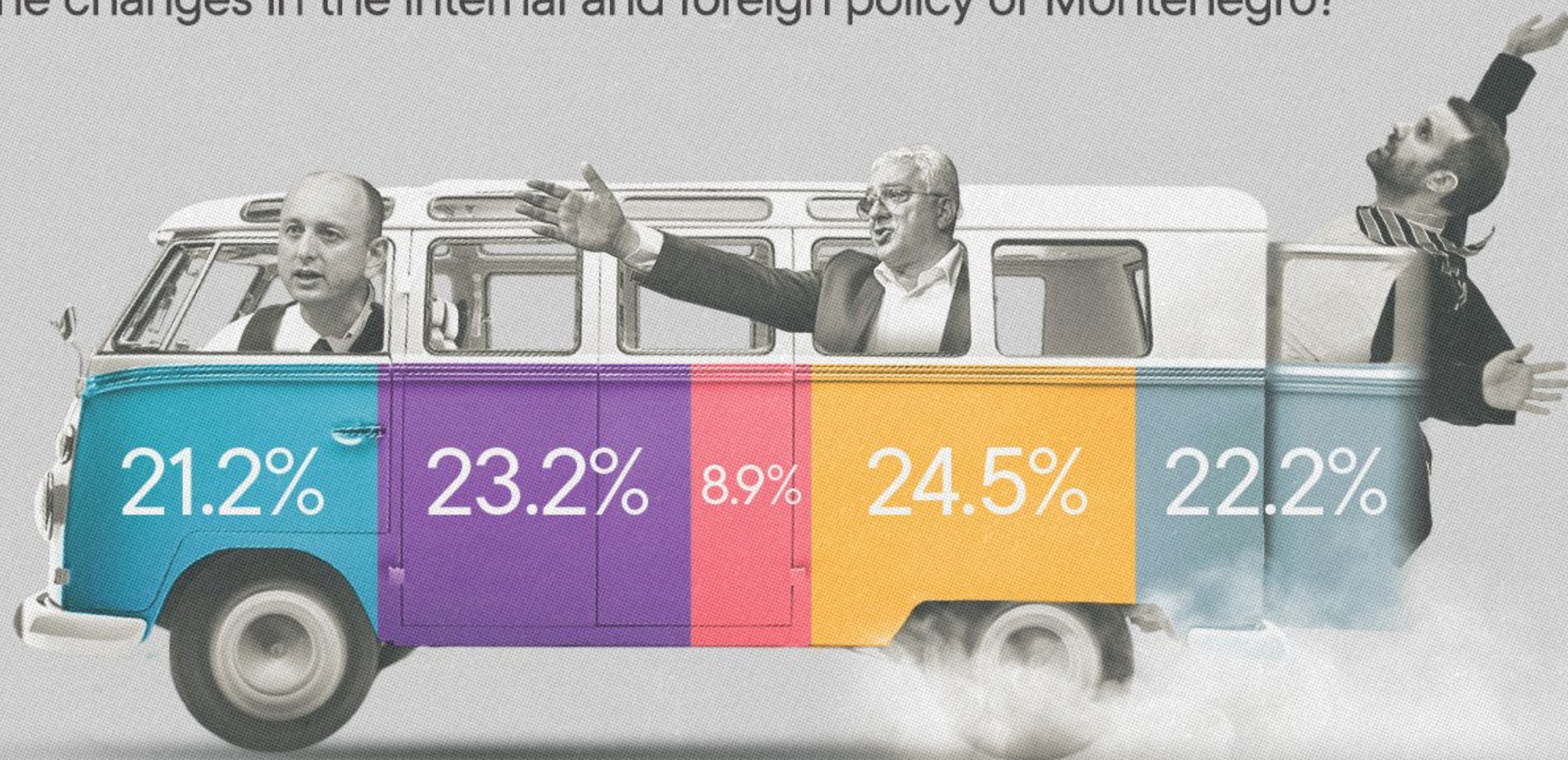
Do you support the reconstruction of the Government by which the parties from the coalition For the Future of Montenegro would enter the executive power?

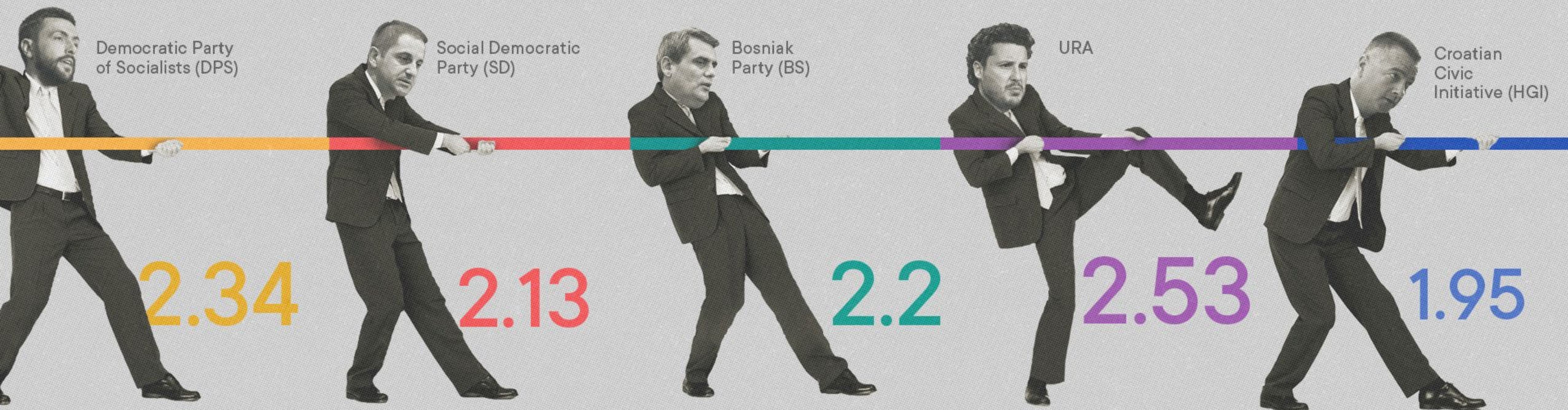

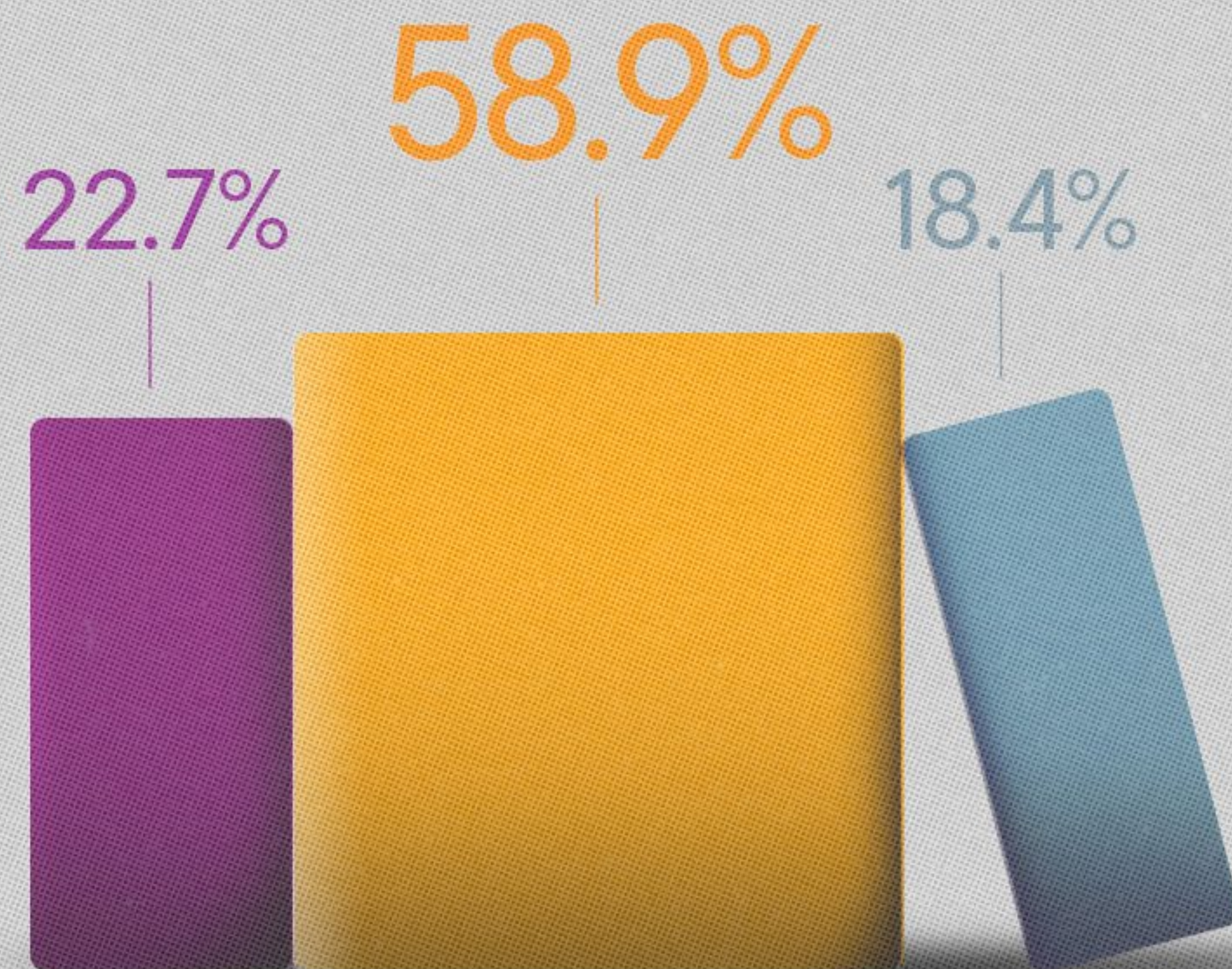

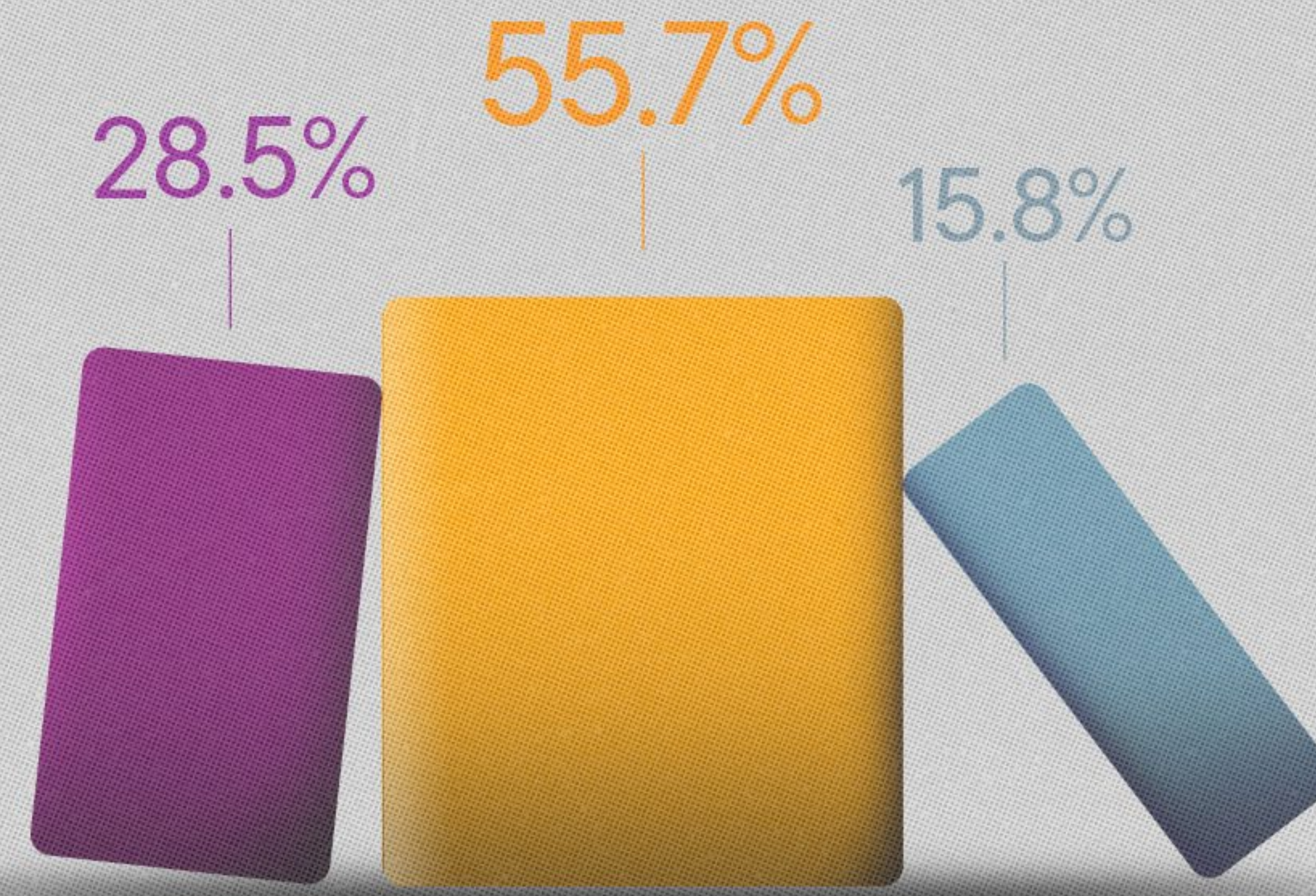


Should religious education be introduced in schools?

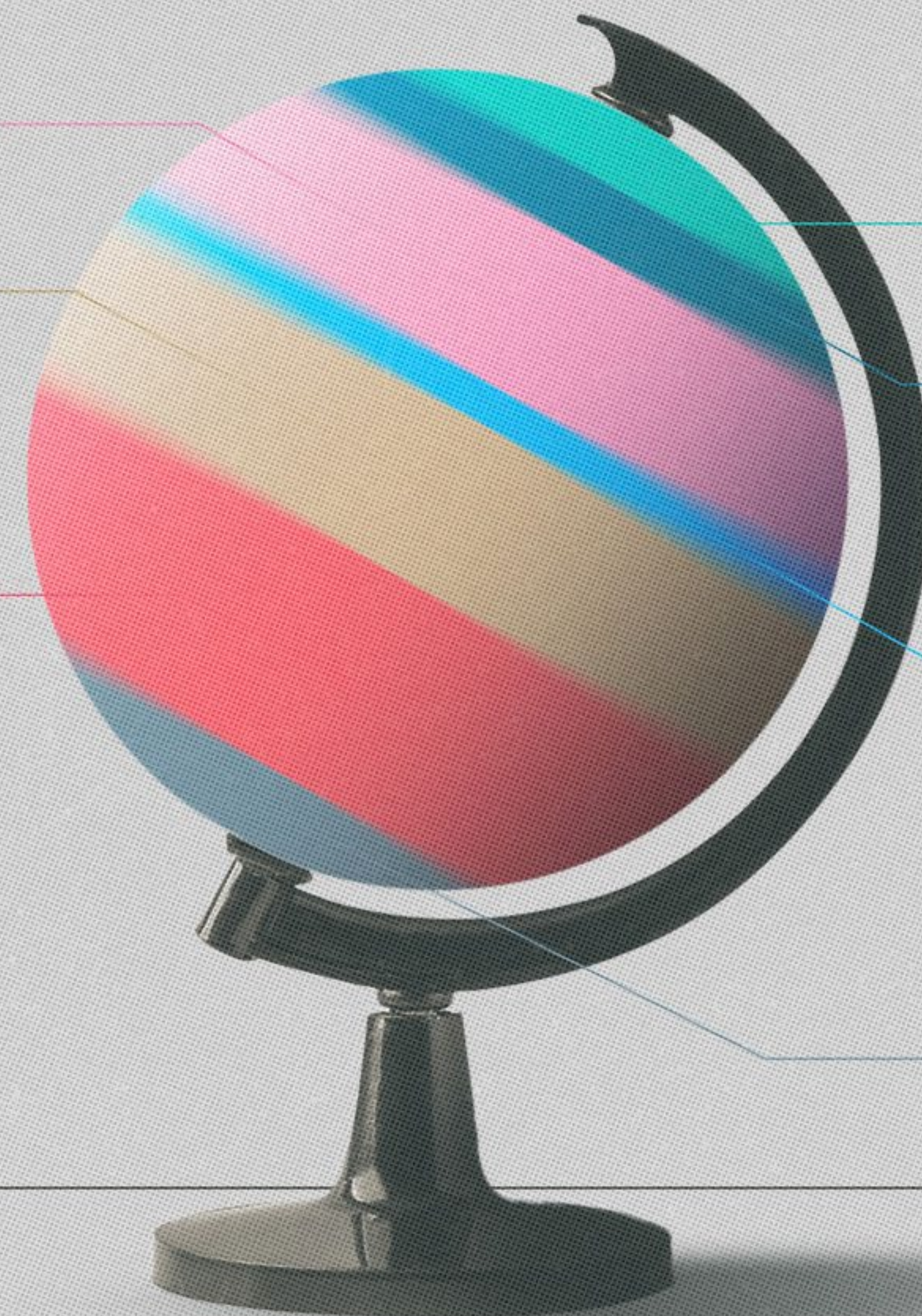


Who, in your opinion, is responsible for the poor results of our students on the PISA test?

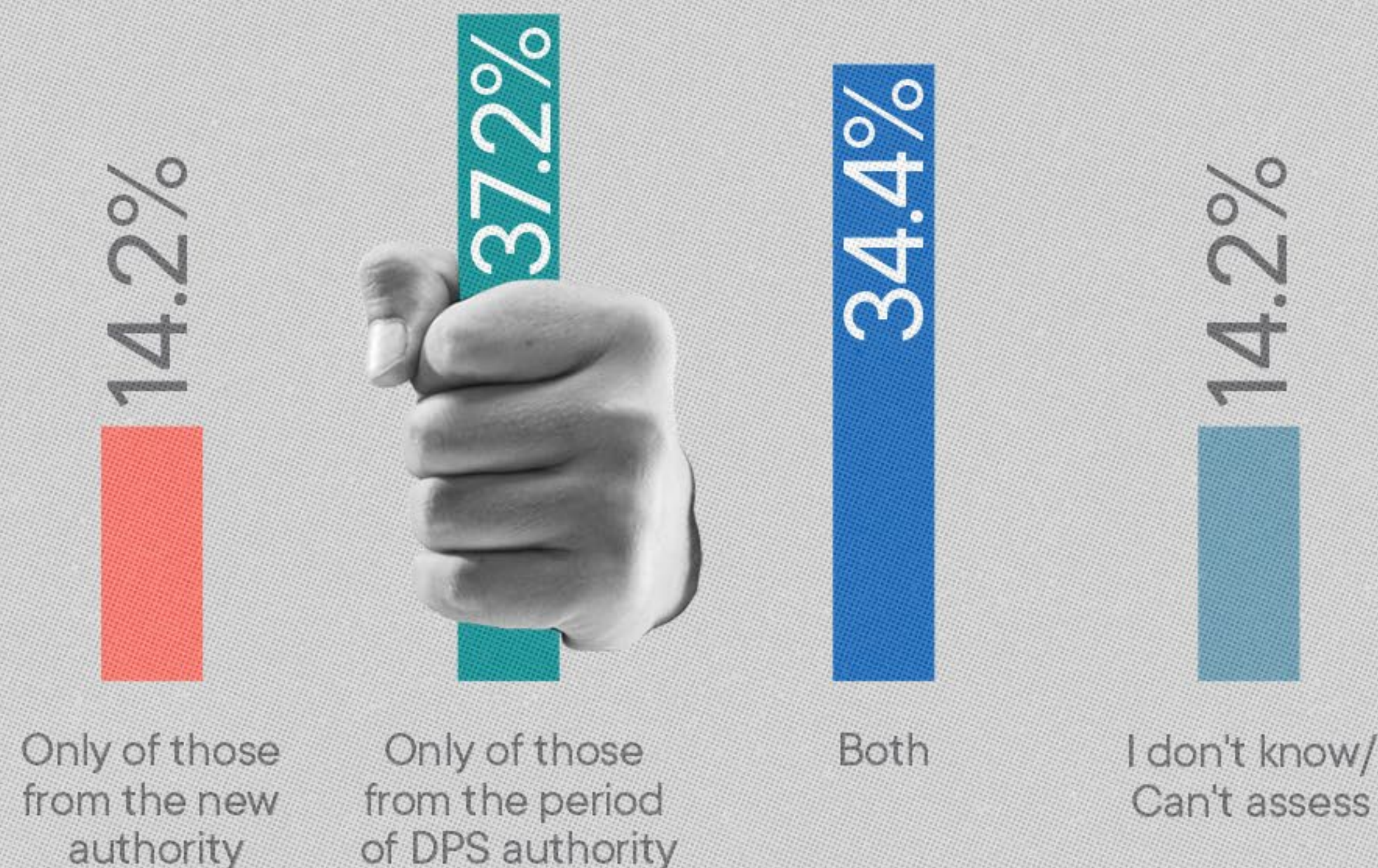


Do the institutions today process the new governing authority or only of those from the period of DPS authority?

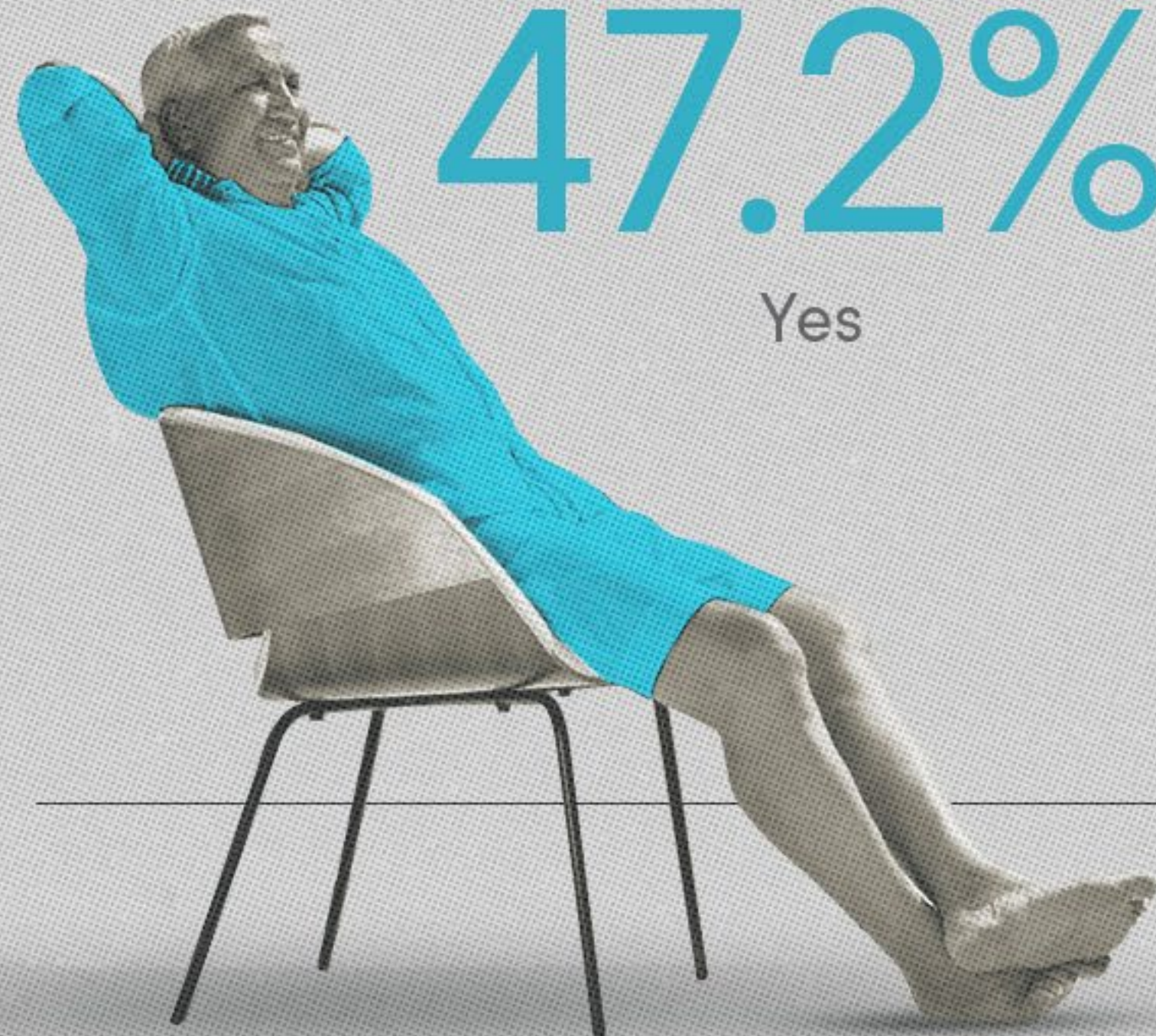




Do you agree with the Government's decision to increase the minimum pension to EUR 450, while the others are kept at the same level?

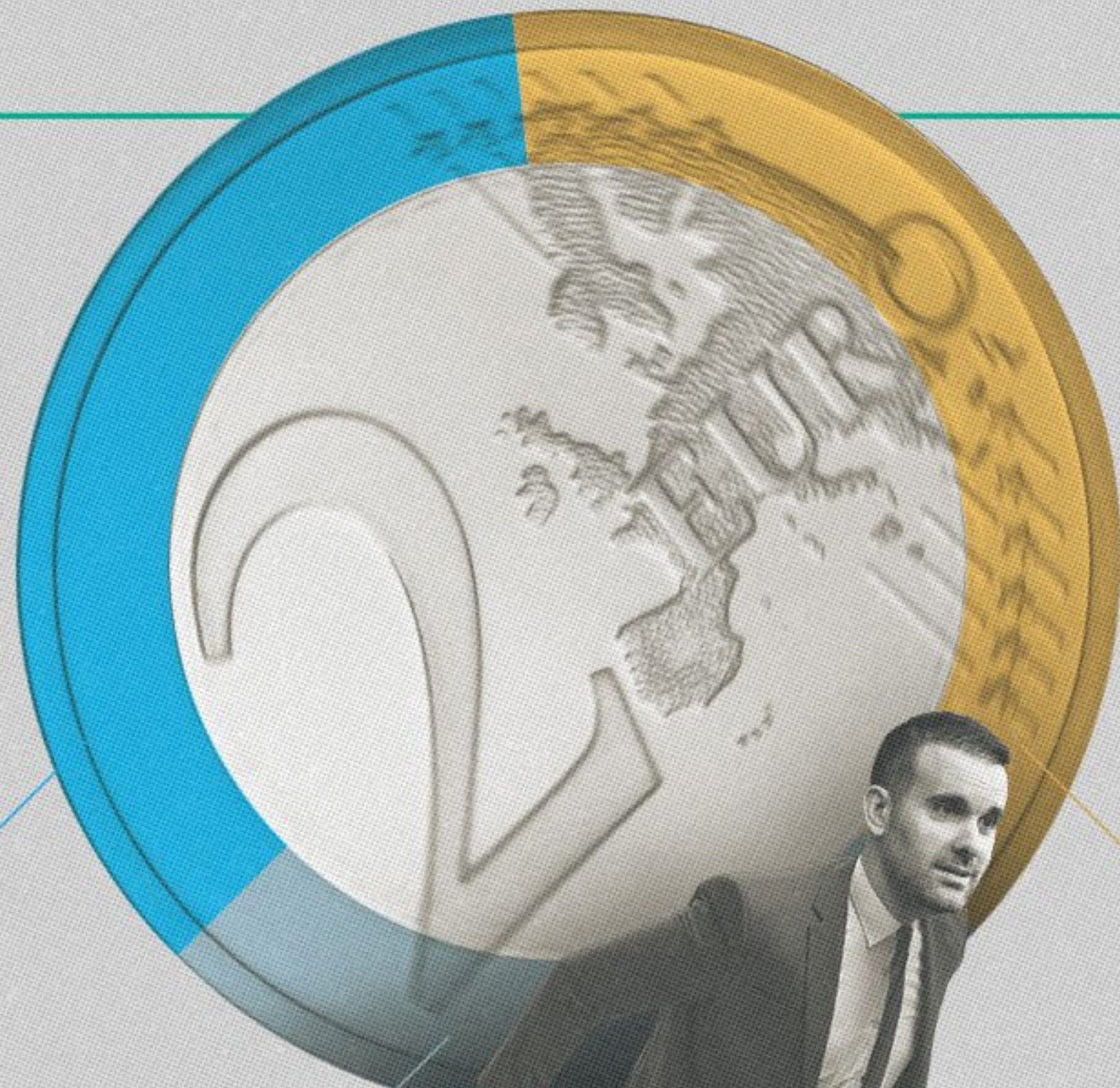
