Research type:	Omnibus - CAPI of average duration of 22 minutes



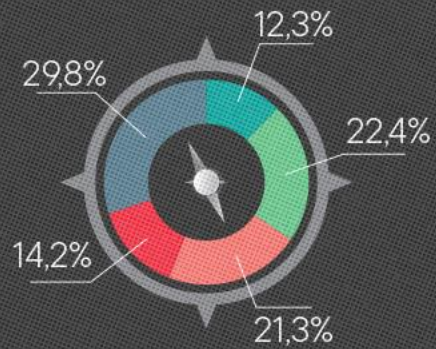

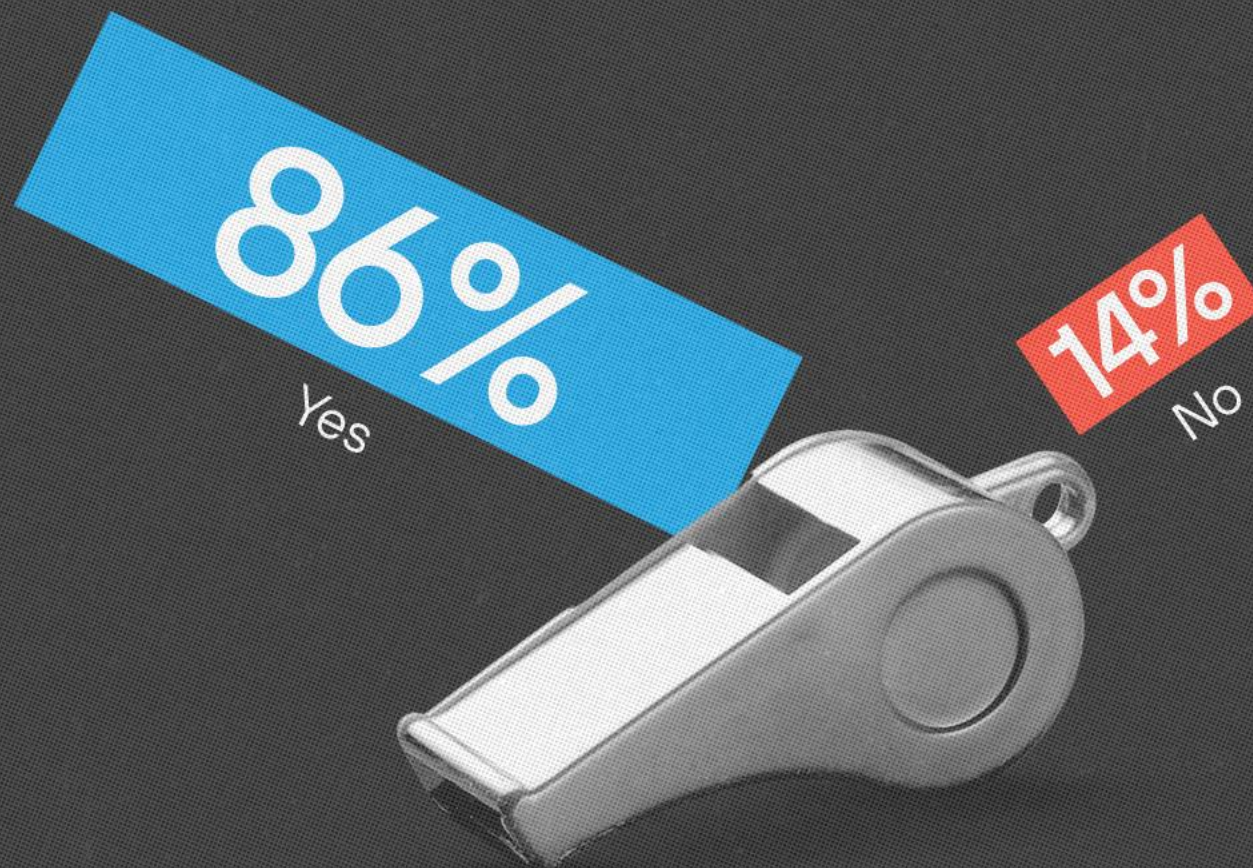

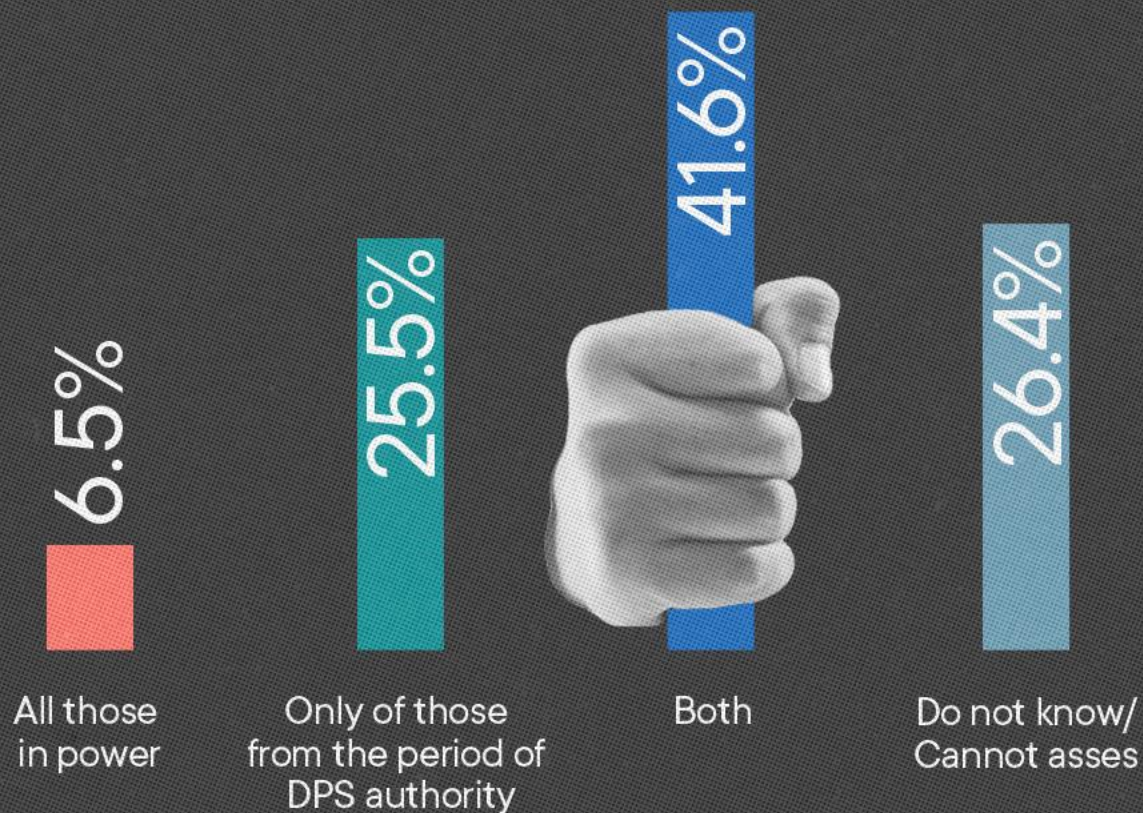
Do the institutions today process the abuse of all those in power or only of those from the period of DPS authority?

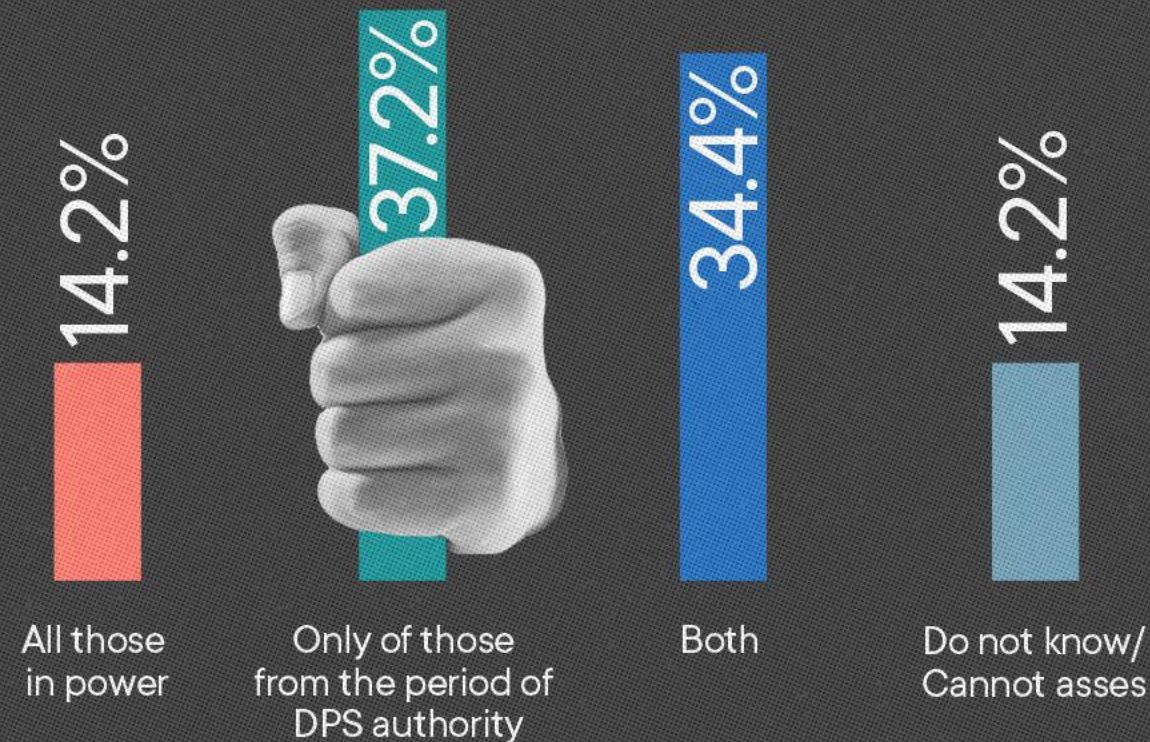
