1. Purpose of the Corrigendum

The purpose of this Corrigendum is to align and clarify the duration of project implementation as stated in the Guidelines for Grant Applicants and the Application Form, in order to ensure consistency across all Call documents and equal treatment of applicants.

No other provisions of the Call for Proposals are affected by this Corrigendum.

2. Amendment to the Guidelines for Grant Applicants

In the Guidelines for Grant Applicants – Media-Lit, Section 5.6. Duration of the project implementation, page 8, the text:

- “Funds will be allocated for projects implemented within a maximum of 10 months.”

is hereby replaced with the following:

- **“Funds will be allocated for projects implemented between 5 and 10 months (minimum and maximum allowed).”**

3. Amendment to the Application Form

In the Application Form – Checklist, page 11, item 6, the text:

- “6. The duration of the project is between 6 and 12 months (minimum and maximum allowed)”

MediaLit

is hereby replaced with the following:

- **“6. The duration of the project is between 5 and 10 months (minimum and maximum allowed)”**

4. Entry into Force

This Corrigendum enters into force on the date of its publication and applies to all applications submitted after its publication.

Applicants are requested to take this correction into account when preparing and submitting their project proposals.

All other terms and conditions of the Call for Proposals remain unchanged.

5. Publication of Corrected Documents

In line with this Corrigendum a corrected version of the Guidelines for Grant Applicants and Application Form is published alongside this notice and marked as “Corrected version – Corrigendum No. 1”.
